2022/2023 AP Exam Information



AP Exams

It is **not required** to take the AP exam for the AP course that you are enrolled

- Step one:
 - Students must **submit [google form](#)** indicating which AP exams they plan to take and click “Yes” in their collegeboard account that they plan on taking an exam
 - Deadline is **November 10th**
- Step two:
 - **Pay for AP exams**
 - **Must pay between August 26th and November 10th**
 - We will not order any AP exam that has not been paid for in full by **November 10th** *if you think you may be eligible for a fee waiver you will need to indicate this in your google form.
- **\$40 LATE FEE** for orders after November 8th
- **\$40 CANCELTION FEE** for exams cancelled after November 8th
- **\$40 Unused Fee**
- **AP Exam fee= \$96 per exam**
 - Students and parents can pay for the exam fees at the finance center window with Mrs. Violet Chavez or via phone at 559-730-7605 forms of payment accepted include: cash, check, cashier’s check or money order, debit or credit card. Monday-Friday 7:30-11am and 1:00-4:30pm. Please note, safety protocols must be followed

AP Exam Fee Reduction Waivers

VUSD One-Time AP Fee Waiver: Covers the cost of one AP exam. Students can only use one VUSD fee waiver throughout high school and must submit an [application](#) to Mrs. Hernandez (ahernandez2@vusd.org) before November 8th

Need-Based Fee Reduction Waiver: Covers the entire cost of AP exams. You must demonstrate financial need and indicate that you plan on applying for a fee reduction waiver in the google form you submit

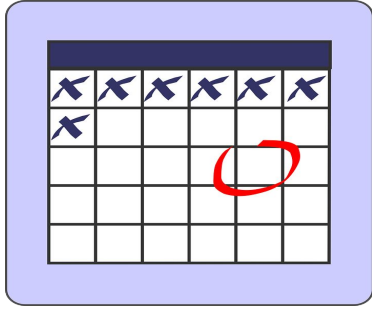

AP College Credit/Placement

- ❖ Most U.S colleges offer credit or advanced placement or both, for qualifying AP scores.
- ❖ The policies for granting credits vary by college. A score of 3,4, or 5 can potentially earn a student credit either in a specific subject area or for elective credits.

 - It is best to refer to the college course catalogs or college websites for specific college credit policies for AP exams
- ❖ Many colleges recognize that your AP scores demonstrate that you already know the material in certain courses they offer and will offer advanced placement.
