Fred Clyncke placed second in the discus.

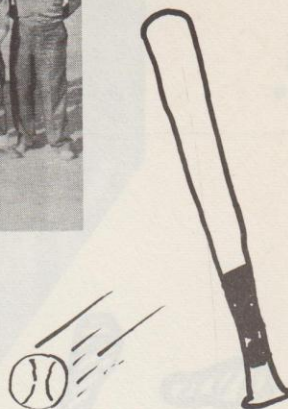

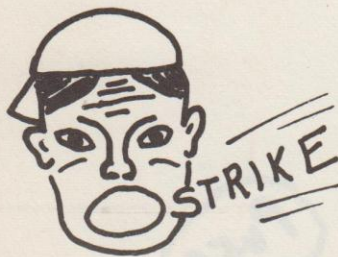
## "BASEBALL"
