**Educational Implications:**

**\*Injuries:**

- \*Immediate first aid for any injury is required. Unless the injury is very minor, the student may require medical treatment to stop the bleeding.
- \*Pain and swelling around the throat and neck area can be more serious than appears, because swelling in this area can obstruct the air passage.
- \*Notify the parent so appropriate treatment can be obtained.
- \*Call the student's physician for advice, if the parents cannot be reached.
- \*Complete an accident report.

**\*Head Injuries:**

- \*Give immediate first aid if the student ever receives a blow to the head.
- \*Notify the parent so appropriate treatment can be obtained, even if there are no obvious signs of bleeding.
- \*Call the student's physician for advice, if the parents cannot be reached.
- \*Complete an accident report.

**\*Spontaneous Bleeding:**

- \*Notify the parent if the student ever complains of pain in muscles, joints or limbs or holds a body part stiff.
