Minutes of Special Called Session Board Meeting
Monday, May 22, 2023

The Bulloch County Board of Education met in a Special Called Session on Monday, May 22, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. in the Board Room at the Central Office for a Student Disciplinary Hearing Appeal.

Board Chairman Glenn Womack called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Attorney Charlie Aaron served as hearing officer.
