

**Bulloch County Board of Education**  
**Minutes of Special Called Session Board Meeting**  
**Tuesday, May 9, 2023**

The Bulloch County Board of Education met in a Special Called Session on Tuesday, May 9, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. in the Board Room at the Central Office for a Student Disciplinary Hearing Appeal.

Board Chairman Glenn Womack served as hearing officer and called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Board members present were as follows: Stuart Tedders, Glenn Womack, Heather Mims, Glennera Martin, Elizabeth Williams, Donna Clifton, Maurice Hill and Superintendent Charles Wilson. Jay Cook was absent.

The Board entered into executive session to review an appeal from a Student Disciplinary Hearing; (O.C.G.A. § 20-2-757); To consider a matter involving the disclosure of personally identifiable information from a student's educational records; (20 USC § 1232g); and to discuss records that are otherwise protected from disclosure under the Open Records Act and there is no reasonable means to consider the records without closing the meeting; (O.C.G.A. § 50-14-3-(b)(4)) regarding J.W.

The Board modified the disciplinary hearing officer's decision of expulsion from Bulloch County Schools with the option of placement to Transitions Learning Center for the remainder of the 2022/2023 school year and the 2023/24 school year. The student is long-term suspended with the option of placement to Transitions Learning Center for the remainder of the 2022/2023 school year and shall be permitted to re-enroll in the Bulloch County School System for the 2023/2024 school year.
