Empower ourselves and each other to pursue purposeful, courageous exploration of our interests and passions to enhance learning, personal fulfillment, and community connections.

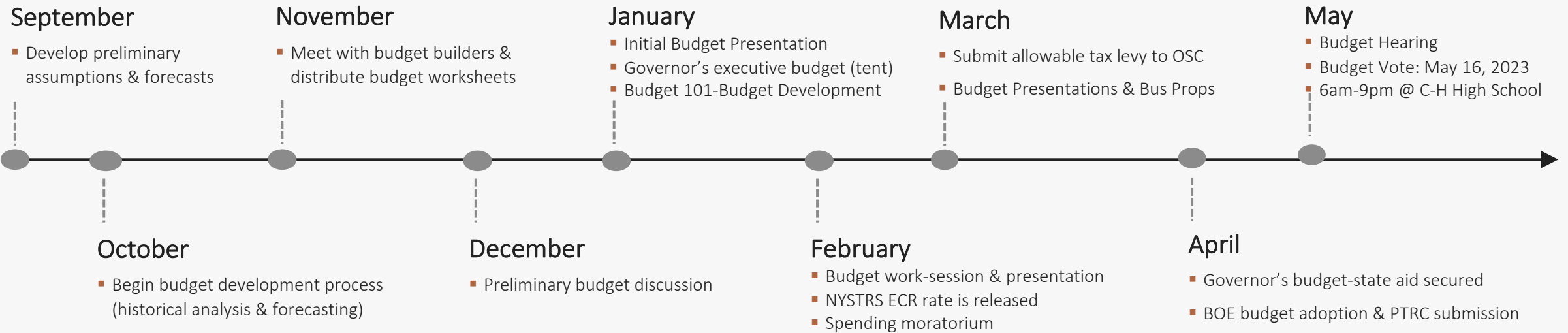
REIMAGINE LEARNING

Revenue Assumptions

➤ STATE AID

- Foundation Aid - Full Phase-in & Additional Increase
- Building & Transportation Aid - Anticipated Increases

➤ INCREASES TO INTEREST INCOME

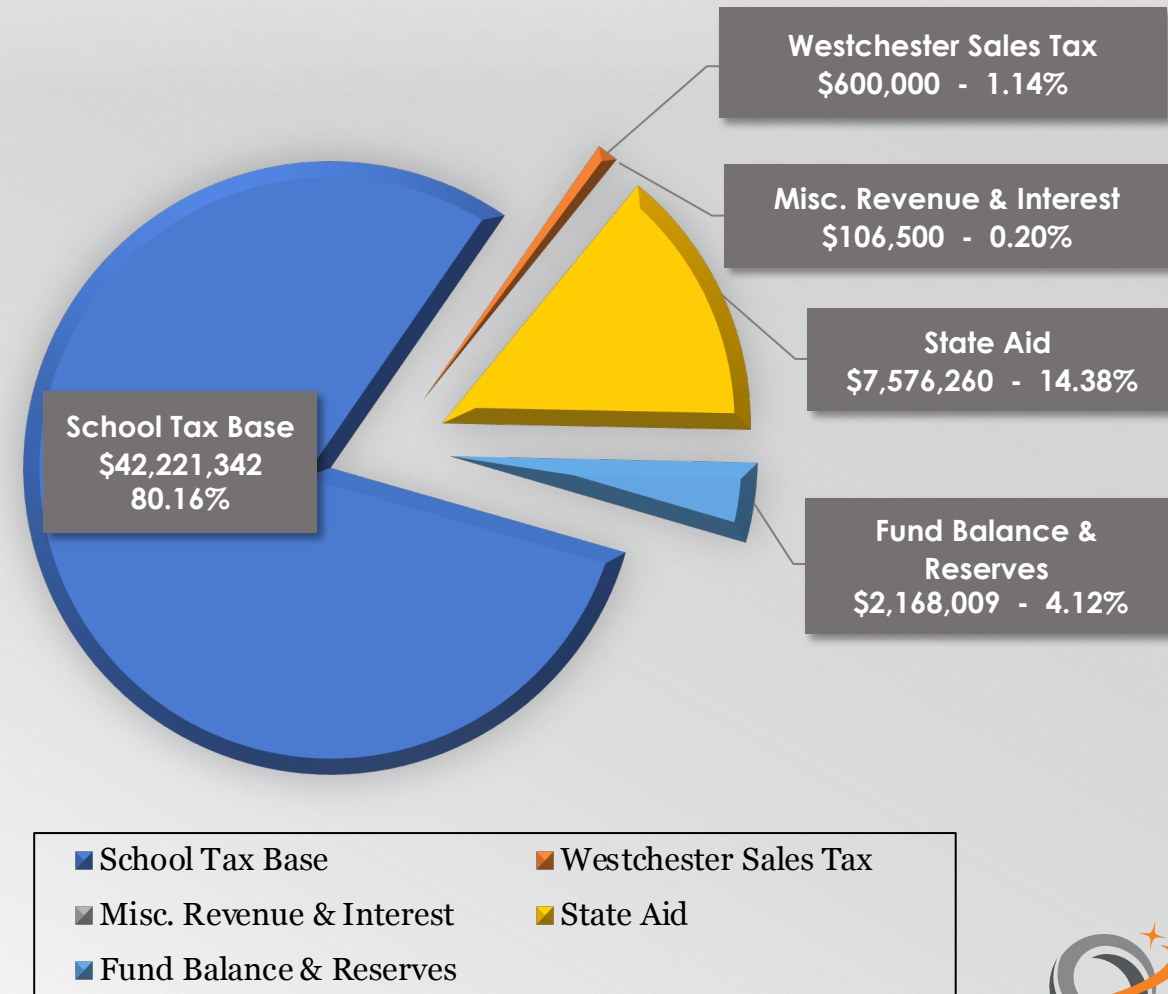
➤ MISCELLANEOUS REVENUE

- Westchester County Sales Tax & Other Revenue to Remain Stable

➤ TAX LEVY

- Allowable Growth Levy Factor Projected at 2%
- Tax Based Growth Factor – 1.0039 (up from 1.0025)
- No PILOT impacts in 2023-2024

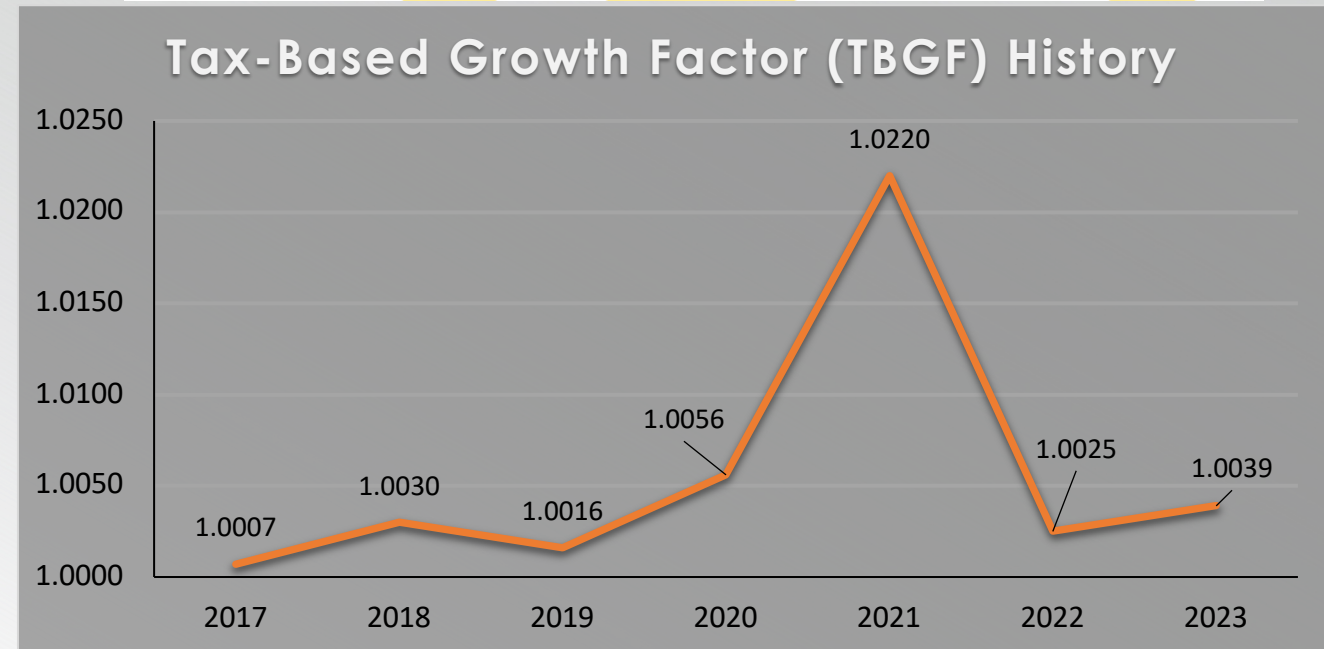
Revenue Analysis 2022-2023 (Prior Year)



Tax-Based Growth Factor (TBGF)

- TBGF measures the quantity change in assessments impacted by new construction, growth, new equipment and improvements made to taxable properties
- This number can change prior to the March 1st filing of Tax Levy

Expenditure Assumptions

- Salaries
 - Contract obligations for all bargaining units are being projected with the exception of our Transportation Unit
 - Staffing will be informed by enrollment and programming goals
- Health insurance increases – 5.5%
- Employer Pension Rates & Payroll taxes on 2023-24 Salaries
 - TRS – Rates projected at 9.5% - 10% (previously 10.29%)
 - ERS – Rates published at 13.1% (previously 11.6%)
 - FICA – FICA Wages to \$160,200 (previously \$147,000)



Expenditure Assumptions

- Special Education placements will minimally remain stable
- BOCES administration, capital & services costs increases (2%)
- Utility Costs – 20 - 25% Initial Increase
- Debt Service projections to incorporate Future Facilities Project (no impact to “local share”)
- Technology Increases to maintain 1:1 device program
- Maintain all Athletics & Co-curricular programs

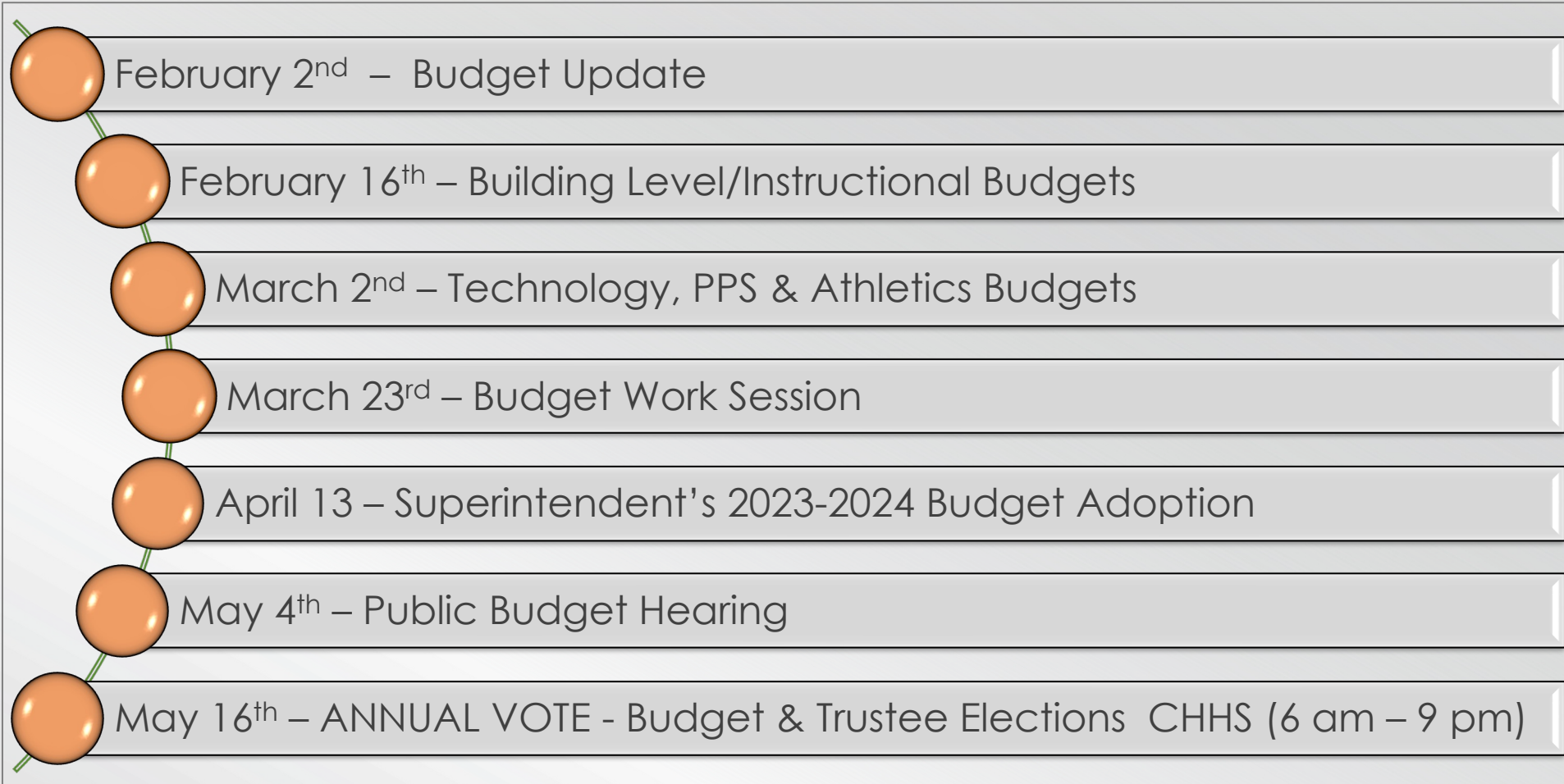


Next Steps

- Incorporate instructional initiatives & priorities
- Prioritize school building and department budget requests
- Determine transportation vehicle replacement needs
- Assess current-year performance
- Monitor Inflation Factors
- Prepare Fund Balance projections
- Continually reassess expenditure projections and performance

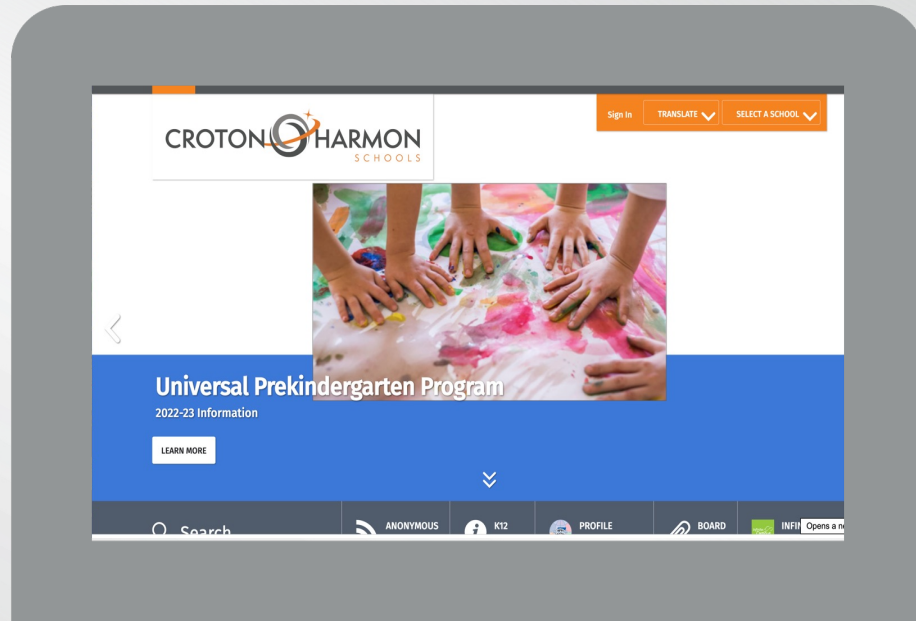
