<b>Blazers</b>	All ages	Royal blue RGS blazer + school badge	Fitted and Standard cut available
<b>Shirts</b>	All ages	Plain white (long or short sleeves)	Fitted revere collar blouse (no tie required) Standard cut with collar (tie required)
<b>Ties</b>	All ages	RGS Junior School maroon & blue school tie with House emblem	
<b>Jerseys</b>	All ages	Maroon v-necked jersey or cardigan	Standard cut
<b>Trousers</b>	All ages	Charcoal grey trousers (during warmer weather, tailored grey shorts can be worn)	Fitted and Standard cut available
<b>Skirts</b>	All ages	RGS Pleated kilt Ideal skirt length is mid-knee, but to allow for growth a range of 2 <sup>1/2</sup> cms (1") below the knee to 5cms (2") above the knee is allowed.	
<b>Dresses</b>	All ages	Burgundy & white striped dresses can be worn in the summer term and can also be worn in the warmer weather; in inclement weather the skirt or trousers can be worn.	
<b>Socks &amp; Tights</b>	All ages	Navy tights or socks with kilts. Charcoal grey or black socks with trousers. White ankle (not trainer) socks may be worn in the summer term only and with summer dresses.	
<b>Shoes</b>	All ages	The general guideline is plain, black, flat, sensible shoes of either lace-up, Velcro, slip on or bar style, all free from contrasting decoration. They should be leather or leather-type, not canvas, or suede. Soles should be of a subdued colour. No trainers or boots.	
<b>Coats</b>	All ages	When outside, students may wish to wear a coat in addition to their blazer.	
<b>Bags</b>	Year 3 & 4	New starters entering Year 3 or Year 4 need to purchase a blue drawstring shoe bag from Schoolblazer.
