BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of School Directors of the Pleasant Valley School District, Brodheadsville, Monroe County, Pennsylvania that the Board hereby takes action to close the Eldred School located in Kunkletown, Monroe County, Pennsylvania, having complied with the provisions of Section 7-780 of the Pennsylvania School Code of 1949, as amended.

“It is with heavy hearts that the Board and administration close the Eldred Elementary School. It is no reflection on the school or the fine staff that worked there or the students who attended. However, at this point in time, declining enrollment has dictated the closure and we regret this action.”
