Building Information

Pleasant Valley Elementary School located in the western part of the district and educating approximately 1220 students in grades kindergarten through three, has a promotion rate of 99.51%.


Pleasant Valley Intermediate School also located in the western part of the district and educating approximately 1122 students in grades four through six, has a promotion rate of 100%.

Pleasant Valley Middle School located on the main campus of the district has a student population of approximately 801 students in grades seven and eight and a promotion rate of 99.2%.

Pleasant Valley High School offers a wide variety of programs for approximately 1847 students in grades 9 through 12 and has a promotion rate of 97.26%.

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Percentage of Students Scoring Proficient or Advanced

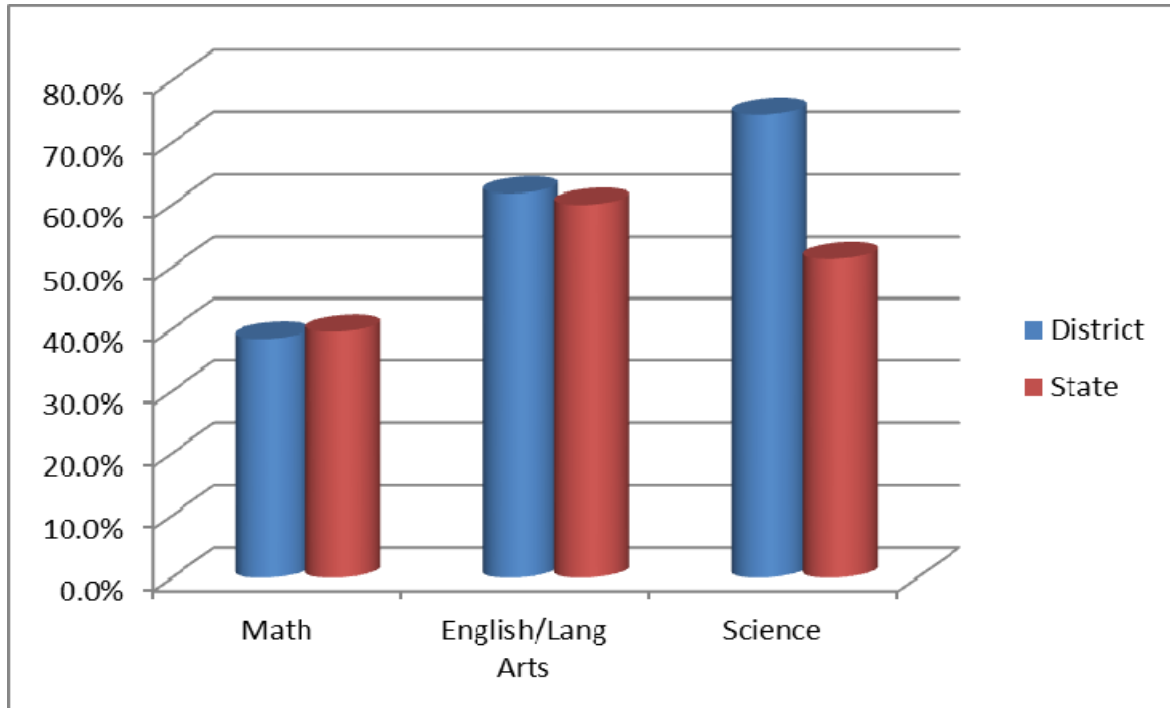

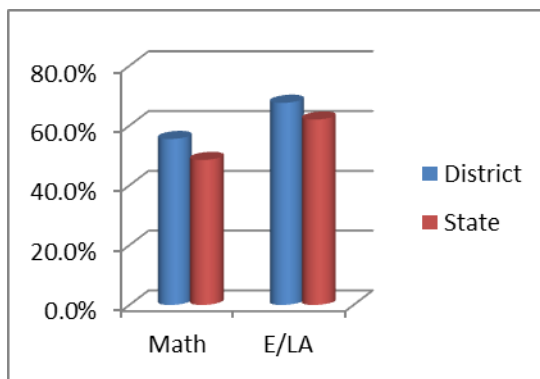

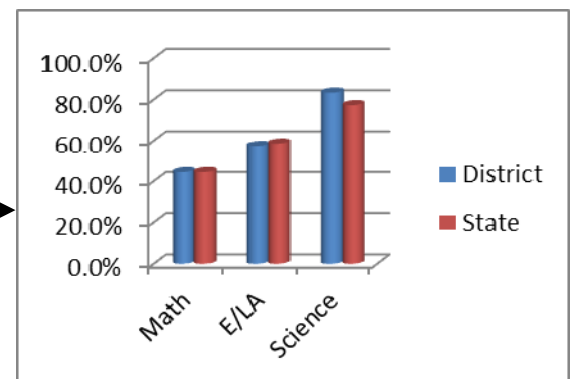


District Assessment Information as Compared to the State – By Grade



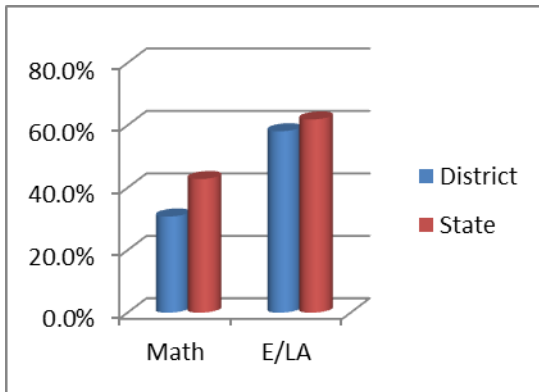

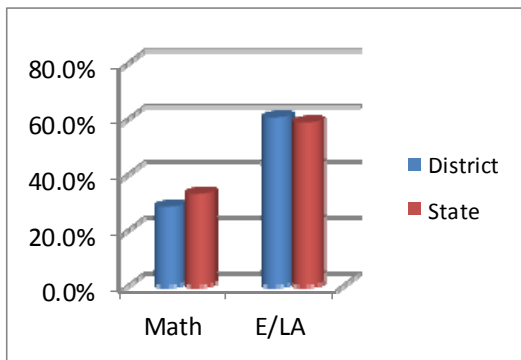
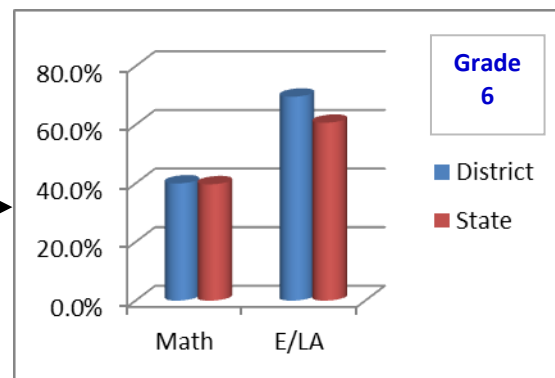
