The Pleasant Valley School District is located in the southwestern corner of Monroe County in northeastern Pennsylvania, serving more than 4800 students, kindergarten through twelfth grade in four schools.

Building Information

Pleasant Valley Elementary School located in the western part of the district and educating approximately 1241 students in grades kindergarten through three, has a promotion rate of 99.59%.

Pleasant Valley Intermediate School also located in the western part of the district and educating approximately 1041 students in grades four through six, has a promotion rate of 99.82%.


Pleasant Valley Middle School located on the main campus of the district has a student population of approximately 799 students in grades seven and eight and a promotion rate of 99%.

Pleasant Valley High School offers a wide variety of programs for approximately 1783 students in grades 9 through 12 and has a promotion rate of 96.97%.

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Percentage of Students Scoring Proficient or Advanced

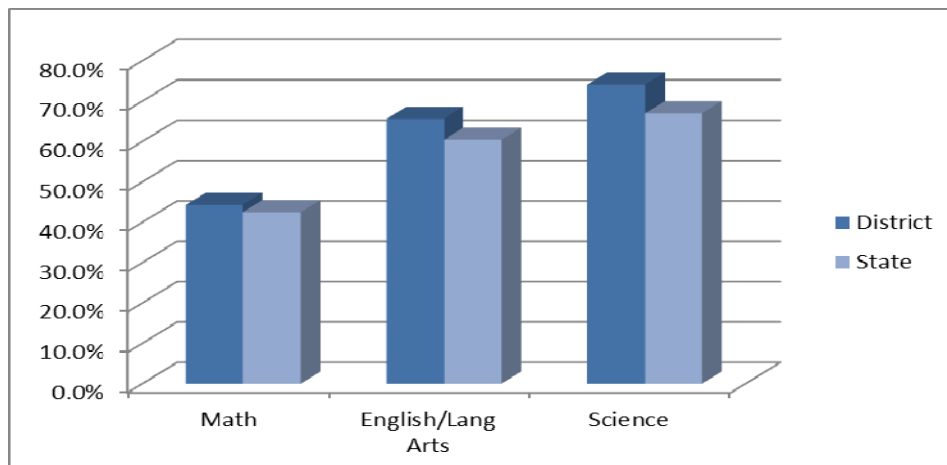

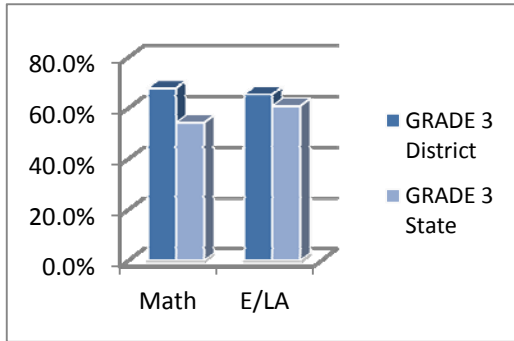

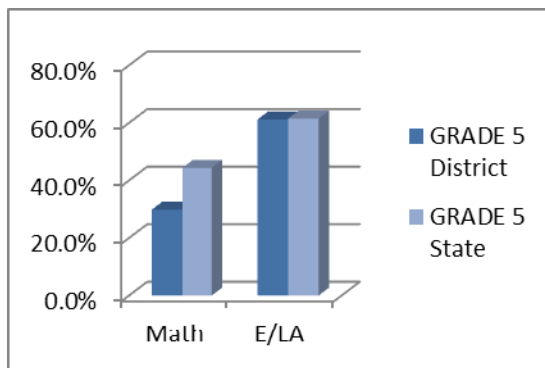
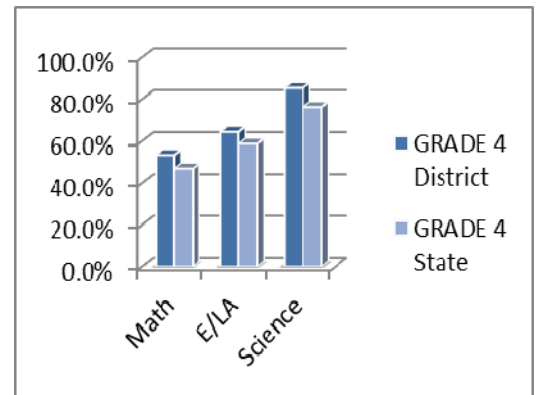


District Assessment Information as Compared to the State – By Grade

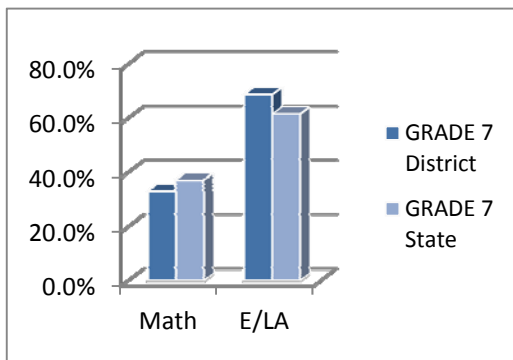
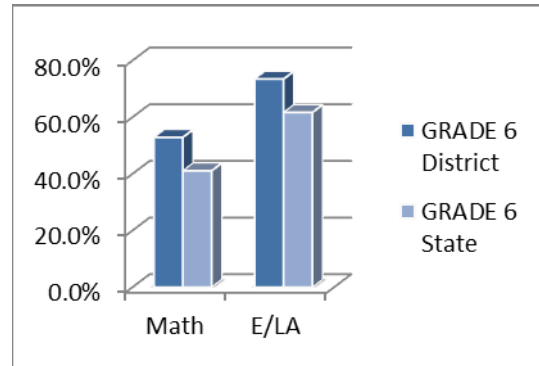
