Building Information

Pleasant Valley Elementary School located in the western part of the district and educating approximately 1190 students in grades kindergarten through three, has a promotion rate of 99.68%.


Pleasant Valley Intermediate School also located in the western part of the district and educating approximately 1037 students in grades four through six, has a promotion rate of 100.00%.

Pleasant Valley Middle School located on the main campus of the district has a student population of approximately 752 students in grades seven and eight and a promotion rate of 98.87%.

Pleasant Valley High School offers a wide variety of programs for approximately 1708 students in grades 9 through 12 and has a promotion rate of 97.25%.

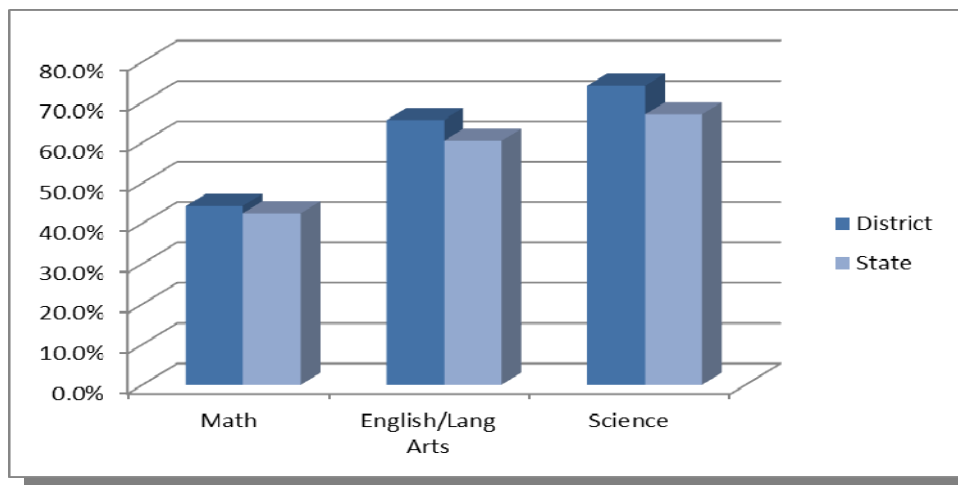

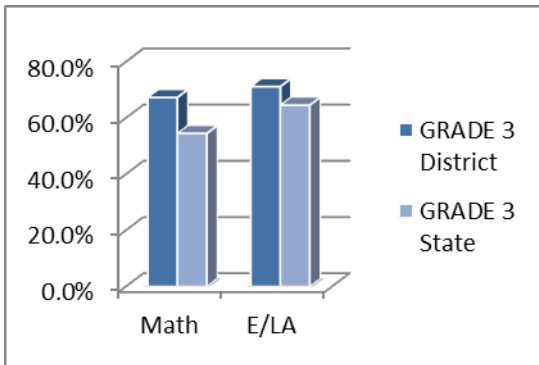

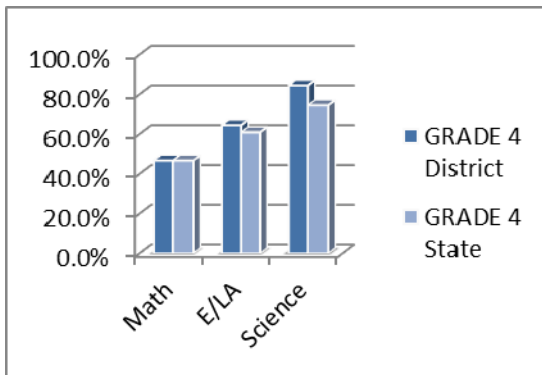

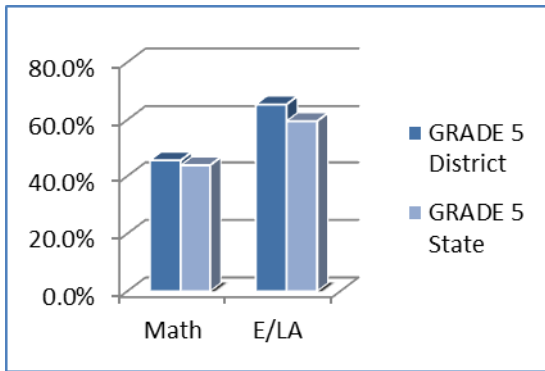
District PSSA Information as Compared to the State – By Grade



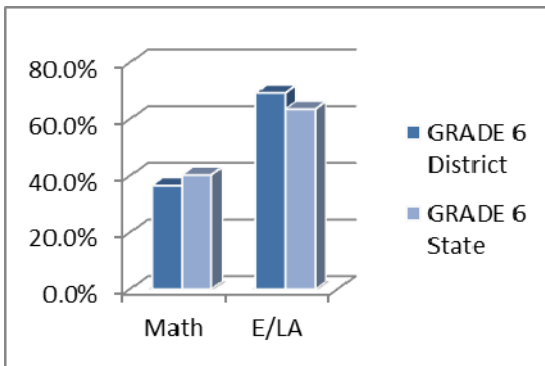

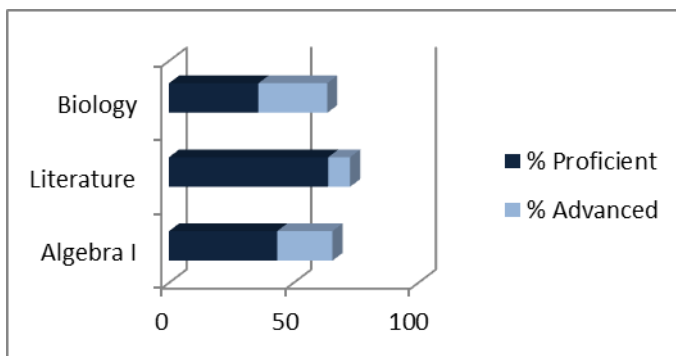
