Join the Klein ISD Surrogate Parent Program

What is the role of the surrogate parent?

- Provide a parental voice for assigned students in the school setting
- Advocate educationally on behalf of their assigned students
- Support the students' voice
- Learn Special Education Law and Processes

What is the Surrogate Parent Program?

A federally mandated support program to assist students found to:

- not have a "parent" as defined by the law
- be in state conservatorship
- be an unaccompanied youth
- not have a parent that can be located

Who can be a surrogate parent?

An individual who is **not** an employee of

- The Texas Education Agency
- The school district
- Dept. of Family & Protective Services
- Child Protective Services
- Residential Treatment Centers and Facilities
- Persons found to not have a conflict of interest
- Persons wanting to support the voice of students who do not have a "parent."
