The Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) course prepares the CNA student to provide care to patients/residents in a Skilled Nursing Facility. The students learn and master a wide variety of skills that are needed in the Healthcare system.



The course provides opportunity to use the clinical skills and apply the learning in the Skills Nursing Facility for 100 hours which makes the student eligible to take the state CNA Exam.











CNA COURSE

HOW DO I QUALIFY FOR THE COURSE?

- Must pass a basic math and English pre-entrance test with 70% or hetter
- Must have valid CA drivers license or ID and Social Security Card or I-TIN_
- Must be fully vaccinated against COVID, and if eligible, must have hooster vaccine.

Course Requirements and Expectations:

Classroom Time:

- * Patient Care
- * Vitals, Screenings, Procedures, Etiquette * Theory and Clinical
- * Skills check-off

Hands-on learning: students are expected to be interactive throughout the course.

Clinical Hours: Students are required to complete 100 Clinical hours in a Skilled Nursing Facility, making students eligible to take the American Red Cross CNA Exam after completion of the course.

Course includes: Theory and Clinical training, textbook, skills workbook, Uniform, and fingerprinting fee.

The CNA exam will be scheduled during the course: (Student will be responsible for \$120.00 exam fee at time of exam)
