### **OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS**

Roll Call

The Board of School Trustees of the Fort Wayne Community Schools met in regular session in the Lester L. Grile Administrative Center on Monday, January 9, 2006, at 7:02 p.m. President Carol J. Coen called the meeting to order with the following members in attendance:

Members absent: none

Election of Officers 2006 President Carol J. Coen asked for nominations for office of President of the Board of School Trustees for 2006. Stephen Corona nominated Geoff Paddock; this was seconded by Kurt A. Walborn. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Carol J. Coen asked for nominations for the office of Vice President of the Board of School Trustees for 2006. Robert A. Armstrong nominated Kurt A. Walborn; this was seconded by Stephen Corona. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Carol J. Coen asked for nomination for the office of Secretary of the Board of School Trustees for 2006. Jon J. Olinger nominated Kweku Akan; this was seconded by Kurt A Walborn. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Carol J. Coen turned the meeting over to the new President, Geoff Paddock.

Appointment of Treasurer and Deputy Treasurers Dr. Wendy Robinson, superintendent, presented the following recommendation concerning the appointment of Treasurer and Deputy Treasurers for the calendar year 2006:

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that Sherry L. Nidlinger be appointed as treasurer and Stefan W. Pittenger and Marcella A. Degitz as deputy treasurers for calendar year 2006, and that bonds for these positions be set as follows:

Treasurer \$200,000 Deputy Treasurers \$50,000

It is further recommended that the administration be granted authority to execute any corporate resolutions required by the various banking depositories.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: The General Powers Act of 1965 as Amended (IC 20-5-3-1), provides for appointment of a treasurer and deputy treasurers at the same time that the new board organizes.

Having two deputy treasurers better ensures timely deposits, investments, and continuity in money management affairs. Ms. Nidlinger serves as the full-time treasurer for the corporation while Mr. Pittenger and Ms. Degitz serve the district as director of fiscal affairs and supervisor of accounting, respectively.

IC 20-5-3-4 provides that the treasurer and deputy treasurers give a bond for the faithful performance of duty in an amount determined by the governing body. The cost of these bonds for 2006 will be \$1150.

A motion was made by Kurt A. Walborn, seconded by Kweku Akan, that the recommendation concerning the Appointment of Treasurer and Deputy Treasurers be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Approval of Minutes – December 12, 2005 A motion was made by Kweku Akan, seconded by Jon J. Olinger, that the minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees held December 12, 2005, be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Robinson presented the vouchers for the periods ending December 9, 2005, and December 28, 2005, with the recommendation the vouchers be approved. A motion was made by Kweku Akan, seconded by Robert A. Armstrong, that the vouchers appearing in the listing numbered 05-23 and 05-24 be approved without exception. **RELATED INFORMATION**: This bid is for biodiesel fuel, premium diesel fuel, and gasoline for FWCS buses and maintenance vehicles. The estimated gallonage will be 600,000 for diesel fuel and 120,000 for gasoline. The bid was performed under a cooperative purchasing agreement with the City of Fort Wayne. The Invitation to Bid offered each vendor the opportunity to bid (a) a firm price, (b) a mark-up or mark-down price based on OPIS, or (c) another alternative pricing structure with optional contract periods of one, two, or three years.

Invitations to Bid were mailed to ten prospective bidders with three responding. No firm price bids were received. The following bids were received based on an adjustment factor per gallon.
