Oath of Office

FWCS Legal Counsel William Sweet, Esq. administered the Oath of Office to reelected Board member Mark GiaQuinta. Newly elected Board members Julie Hollingsworth, Jordan Lebamoff and Lisa Olinger had taken the Oath of Office prior to the meeting.

Election of Officers

Mark GiaQuinta asked for nominations to fill the positions of President, Vice President and Secretary for the Board of School Trustees for 2011. Jordan Lebamoff nominated the slate of Becky Hill for Secretary, Stephen Corona for Vice President and Mark GiaQuinta for President, seconded by John Peirce. Appointment of Treasurer and Deputy Treasurers Dr. Wendy Robinson, superintendent, presented the following recommendation concerning the appointment of Treasurer and Deputy Treasurers for the calendar year 2011:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that Sherry L. Nidlinger be appointed as treasurer and Stefan W. Pittenger and Marcella A. Degitz as deputy treasurers for calendar year 2011, and that bonds for these positions be set as follows:

Ms. Nidlinger serves as the full-time treasurer for the corporation while Mr. Pittenger and Ms. Degitz serve the district as director of fiscal affairs and supervisor of accounting, respectively.
