OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS

Roll Call

The Board of School Trustees of the Fort Wayne Community Schools met in regular session in the Lester L. Grile Administrative Center on Monday, January 12, 2004, at 7:04 p.m. President Stephen Corona called the meeting to order with the following members in attendance:

Election of Officers

President Steve Corona asked for nominations for the office of President of the Board of School Trustees for 2004. Robert A. Armstrong nominated Carol J. Coen. Carl A. Johnson made a motion to close the nominations for President; this was seconded by Jon J. Olinger. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none. Carol J. Coen was unanimously elected President

Stephen Corona turned the meeting over to the new President, Carol J. Coen.

President Carol J. Coen asked for nominations for the office of Vice President of the Board of School Trustees for 2004. Stephen Corona nominated Geoff Paddock. Jon J. Olinger made a motion to close the nominations for Vice President; this was seconded by Robert A. Armstrong. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none. Geoff Paddock was unanimously elected Vice President.

Carol J. Coen asked for nominations for the office of Secretary of the Board of School Trustees for 2004. Kurt A. Walborn nominated Jon J. Olinger. Stephen Corona made a motion to close the nominations for Secretary; this was seconded by Carl A. Johnson. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none. Jon J. Olinger was unanimously elected Secretary.

Dr. Wendy Robinson, superintendent, presented the following recommendation concerning the appointment of Treasurer and Deputy Treasures for the calendar year 2004:

Appointment of Treasurer and Deputy Treasurers

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that Sherry L. Nidlinger be appointed as treasurer and Stefan W. Pittenger and Marcella A. Degitz as deputy treasurers for calendar year 2004, and that bonds for these positions be set as follows: Treasurer - \$200,000 and Deputy Treasurers - \$50,000

RELATED INFORMATION: The General Powers Act of 1965 as Amended (IC 20-5-3-1), provides for appointment of a treasurer and deputy treasurers at the same time that the new board organizes.

Having two deputy treasurers better ensures timely deposits, investments, and continuity in money management affairs. Ms. Nidlinger serves as the full-time treasurer for the corporation while Mr. Pittenger and Ms. Degitz serve the district as director of fiscal affairs and supervisor of accounting, respectively.

IC 20-5-3-4 provides that the treasurer and deputy treasurers give a bond for the faithful performance of duty in an amount determined by the governing body. The cost of these bonds for 2004 will be \$1150.

A motion was made by Kurt A. Walborn, seconded by Jon J. Olinger, that the recommendation concerning Appointment of Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Approval of Minutes – December 8, 2003 A motion was made by Carl A. Johnson, seconded by Robert A. Armstrong, that the minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees held December 8, 2003, be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Wendy Robinson, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

Elmhurst High School Report

At the district's smallest high school, staff and students are really big on learning! Elmhurst High School Principal Laura Taliaferro, teachers David Flesch and Brett Adams, and Student Council President Cristina Herrera reported on their school's "Road to Academic Success."

Vouchers

Dr. Robinson presented the vouchers for the periods ending December 11, 2003, and December 31, 2003, with the recommendation the vouchers be approved. A motion was made by Robert A. Armstrong, seconded by Carl A. Johnson, that the vouchers appearing in the listings numbered 03-24 and 03-25 be approved without exception. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Application for Common School Fund Loan Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Application for Common School Fund Loan:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of advancement from the Indiana Common School Fund for educational technology equipment for 2004 in the amount of \$1,950,000.

RELATED INFORMATION: Advancements from the Common School Fund provide funds for school districts to purchase educational technology. The Fort Wayne Community Schools (FWCS) will use these moneys to help fund the FWCS technology plan previously submitted to the state. Technology funds are currently insufficient to fund all the technology needs of the school corporation.

Funds are provided as a loan and are awarded to school corporations on the basis of assessed value (AV) per pupil, with low AV per pupil school corporations receiving funds before high AV per pupil corporations. FWCS therefore cannot be assured of receiving the requested advancement.

Should the application be successful, funds will be budgeted in the Debt Service Fund to repay this loan beginning in the year 2005. Interest on the loan is expected to be no more than four percent and is likely to be as low as one percent.

Common School Fund advancements differ from School Technology Advancement Account (STAA) loans, which FWCS receives on an annual basis. Unlike CSF advancements, STAA advancements are given to all applying school corporations, regardless of their assessed value per pupil ranking.

A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Kurt A. Walborn, that the recommendation concerning the Application for Common School Fund Loan be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Purchase of Properties – North Side High School Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Purchase of Properties – North Side High School:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board authorize the purchase of the following properties located near North Side High School:

RELATED INFORMATION: These two adjoining properties have one owner. The appraisal was done on the combined properties. The current school site is significantly below the state minimum acreage recommendation. Funds are within budget.

A motion was made by Robert A. Armstrong, seconded by Jon J. Olinger, that the recommendation concerning the Purchase of Properties – North Side High School be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Ratification of Fort Wayne Classified Association Group Contract Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Ratification of Fort Wayne Classified Association Group Contract:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board ratify revisions to the collective bargaining agreement between Fort Wayne Classified Association and Fort Wayne Community Schools.

RELATED INFORMATION: On Thursday, November 20, 2003 Fort Wayne Community Schools and Fort Wayne Classified Association reached a tentative agreement on a three-year contract. The 2000 – 2003 contract expired on December 31, 2003. A summary of the changes for the 2004 – 2006 contract is as follows:

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Pay Increase and Retirement Buyout for Teamsters:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board ratify a wage increase and revisions to the collective bargaining agreement covering retirement and health insurance subsidy for Fort Wayne Community Schools Bus Drivers represented by Teamsters Local 414.

RELATED INFORMATION: Fort Wayne Community Schools and bus drivers represented by Teamsters Local 414 reached an agreement on wage opener negotiations of the current 2003-2005 contract. A summary is as follows:

A motion was made by Robert A. Armstrong, seconded by Kurt A. Walborn, that the recommendation concerning the Pay Increase and Retirement Buyout for Teamsters be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the American Electric Power (AEP) Grant – Geyer Middle School:

Power (AEP) Grant – Geyer Middle School:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of a grant from AEP for Geyer Middle School in the amount of \$7,000.

RELATED INFORMATION: AEP is offering end-of-year funds to schools for supporting math, science, and enrichment programs. Geyer plans to use these funds to provide students with hands-on experience in the area of weather using the WeatherNet Program. Students will become part of a national network of schools that gather and communicate information about the world around them using the internet. This program will be an interdisciplinary school-wide program addressing educational standards in Mathematics, Technology, Science, Geography, and Mass Communication.

Computer teacher, Max Blank submitted this competitive grant which addresses advancement intended and outlined in Strategy I, Personally Appropriate Education.

A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Kurt A. Walborn, that the recommendation concerning the American Electric Power (AEP) Grant – Geyer Middle School be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Laura Bush Foundation Grant:

Laura Bush Foundation Grant

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of grants from the Laura Bush Foundation for America's Libraries in the amount of \$5,000 each for Geyer Middle School, Scott Academy, and Study Elementary School.

RELATED INFORMATION: This competitive grant is made available to school libraries to update, extend, and diversify book collections for students in elementary, middle, or high schools. Preference is given to schools in which 90% or more of the schools' population receives free or reduced lunch.

Geyer Middle School would use the funds to double their present biography collection, which would equate to 1.5 biographies per student. Rita Robbins, media clerk, is the contact person.

Scott Academy would add additional seating for their story and reference corner. The majority of the funds would be used to add approximately 500 new books to their Easy Reader, fiction, nonfiction, reference and biography sections. Aukisah Williams, media clerk, is the contact person.

Study Elementary would update reference materials such as almanacs, atlases and encyclopedia for upper grades and provide early-leveled reading materials for primary students. Rose Huston, media clerk, is the contact person.

This program supports advancement intended and outlined in Strategy VII, Student-Centered Environment.

A motion was made by Robert A. Armstrong, seconded by Kurt A. Walborn, that the recommendation concerning the Laura Bush Foundation Grant be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Title II-B Science Grant:

Title II-B Science Grant

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve application for and acceptance of a Title II-B Science Partnership Grant from the Indiana Department of Education in the amount of \$975,000. The grant is awarded for a period of three years.

RELATED INFORMATION: The No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 authorizes Title II-B as a science partnership competitive grant program. In Indiana, these funds will be used to promote and enhance the inquiry-based/learning cycle approaches to science teaching in grades K-6. The grant is under the direction of Joanne Schafer, Curriculum Coordinator, and addresses Strategy V, Staff Effectiveness and Strategy X, Significant Linkages with Community Resources.

A motion was made by Robert A. Armstrong, seconded by Kurt A. Walborn, that the recommendation concerning the Title II-B Science Grant be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.
