OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS

Roll Call

The Board of School Trustees of the Fort Wayne Community Schools met in regular session in the Lester L. Grile Administrative Center on Monday January 14, 2002, at 7:08 p.m. President Jon J. Olinger called the meeting to order with the following members in attendance:

Members present: Jon J. Olinger, Chairperson

Stephen Corona Carol J. Coen Carl A. Johnson Bettye J. Poignard Donald J. Schaab

Members absent: Jerome F. Henry, Sr.

Election of Officers

President Jon J. Olinger asked for nominations for the office of President of the Board of School Trustees for 2002. Carol J. Coen nominated Stephen Corona. Bettye J. Poignard made a motion to close the nominations for President; this was seconded by Donald J. Schaab. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none. Stephen Corona was unanimously elected President

Jon J. Olinger turned the meeting over to the new President, Stephen Corona.

President Stephen Corona asked for nominations for the office of Vice President and Secretary of the Board of School Trustees for 2002. Bettye J. Poignard nominated Carol J. Coen for Vice President and Donald J. Schaab for Secretary. Carol J. Coen made a motion to close the nominations for Vice President and Secretary; this was seconded by Jon J. Olinger . Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none. Carol J. Coen was unanimously elected Vice President and Donald J. Schaab was unanimously elected Secretary.

Appointment of Treasurer and Deputy Treasurers **RECOMMENDATION:** It was recommended that Sherry L. Nidlinger be appointed as treasurer and Stefan W. Pittenger and Sandra M. Welborn as deputy treasurers for calendar year 2002, and that bonds for these positions be set as follows:

Treasurer \$200,000 Deputy Treasurers \$50,000

RELATED INFORMATION: The General Powers Act of 1965 as Amended (IC 20-5-3-1), provides for appointment of a treasurer and deputy treasurers at the same time that the new board organizes.

Having two deputy treasurers better ensures timely deposits, investments, and continuity in money management affairs. Ms. Nidlinger serves as the full-time treasurer for the corporation while Mr. Pittenger and Ms. Welborn serve the district as director of fiscal affairs and assistant supervisor of accounting, respectively.

IC 20-5-3-4 provides that the treasurer and deputy treasurers give a bond for the faithful performance of duty in an amount determined by the governing body. The cost of these bonds for 2002 will be \$1,150.

Approval of Minutes – December 10, 2001

A motion was made by Donald J. Schaab, seconded by Bettye J. Poignard that the recommendation for the appointment of Treasurer and Deputy Treasurers for the calendar year 2002 be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Bettye J. Poignard, that the minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees held December 10, 2001, be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Thomas Fowler-Finn, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

Pittsburgh Conference Presentations

Following their presentation in October to the Institute for Learning at the University of Pittsburgh, the superintendent and four Fort Wayne Community Schools students were invited to make a presentation to the Forum for Western Pennsylvania School Superintendents on December 6, 2001.

The four students were introduced, came forward, and answered a question with regards to what the presentation meant to them:

Jihan Lee, South Side High School (not present) Julia Leon, North Side High School Allen Sledge, Wayne High School Roderick Sleet, Snider High School

Staff Spotlight – Kathy Yoder

RECOMMENDATION: It was recommended that the Board recognize Kathy Yoder, kindergarten teacher at Washington Center Elementary School, for her contributions to the children and families of Fort Wayne Community Schools.

RELATED INFORMATION: The Staff Spotlight program is the district's method of recognizing employees for outstanding work and commitment to excellence. Kathy Yoder, kindergarten teacher at Washington Center Elementary School, was honored. A video highlighting her accomplishments was shown.

This program addresses advancement intended and outlined in Strategy V, Ensuring Staff Effectiveness; and Strategy VIII, Communicating that Fort Wayne Community Schools is an Excellent School System.

Integrated Math Program Award

RECOMMENDATION: It was recommended that the Board recognize Robert Trammel and Carol Lindquist for their work implementing the integrated math program for Fort Wayne Community Schools.

RELATED INFORMATION: Fort Wayne Community Schools has been notified that the integrated math program will be awarded an Honorable Mention award from the American Association of School Administrators and TIAA-CREF at the annual AASA conference in February 2002.

Olympic Torch Relay

RECOMMENDATION: It was recommended that the Board recognize Michael Floyd, an English teacher at Elmhurst High School, Cody Glass, a sixth-grader at Northwood Middle School, and Paul Robinson, a 12th-grader at North Side High School for carrying the 2002 Olympic torch through Fort Wayne on January 3, 2002.

RELATED INFORMATION: Michael Floyd, Cody Glass and Paul Robinson were among 80 torchbearers from Northeast Indiana who carried the torch for the 2002 Olympic Winter Games through Fort Wayne. They were nominated by family members, friends or colleagues who wrote a 50-to 100-word essay explaining how the nominee embodied the Olympic spirit and provided inspiration to others and their community.

Vouchers

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the vouchers for the period ending December 10, 2001, December 31, 2001, and January 2, 2002, with the recommendation the vouchers be approved. A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger seconded by Bettye J. Poignard, that the vouchers appearing in the listing numbered 01-24, 01-25, and 02-01 be approved without exception. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the money market mutual fund accounts:

Money Market Mutual Fund Accounts **RECOMMENDATION:** It was recommended that the Board authorize the use of money market mutual fund accounts opened with eligible depositories.

RELATED INFORMATION: Indiana Code 5-13-9-2.5 allows school corporations to invest in money market mutual funds through depositories designated by the state board of finance as public funds depositories. The following restrictions apply to investment of public dollars in money market mutual funds:

- The portfolio of the investment company must be limited to direct obligations of the federal government; obligations of federal agencies, instrumentalities, and government-sponsored enterprises; and fully collateralized repurchase agreements backed by federal obligations.
- The investment fund must be rated as AAAm by Standard and Poor's Corporation or Aaa by Moody's Investors Service, Inc.
- The investment in money market mutual funds may not exceed 50 percent of the dollars held by the investment officer that are available for investment.
- The securities are considered to have a stated final maturity of one (1) day.

The money market accounts would be used in addition to current investment vehicles, providing greater investment flexibility and the potential of greater investment earnings.

The Board previously authorized the use of these accounts. According to I.C. 5-13-9-2.4, investment in these funds requires annual Board approval.

A motion was made by Carl A. Johnson, seconded by Jon J. Olinger, that the recommendation concerning the money market mutual fund accounts be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning application for Common School Fund Loan:

Application for Common School Fund Loan

RECOMMENDATION: It was recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of an advancement from the Indiana Common School Fund for educational technology equipment for 2002 in the amount of \$1,950,000.

RELATED INFORMATION: Advancements from the Common School Fund provide funds for school districts to purchase educational technology. The Fort Wayne Community Schools will use these moneys to help fund the Fort Wayne Community Schools technology plan previously submitted to the state. Technology funds are currently insufficient to fund all the technology needs of the school corporation.

Funds are provided as a loan and are awarded to school corporations on the basis of assessed value (AV) per pupil, with low AV per pupil school corporations receiving funds before high AV per pupil corporations. Fort Wayne Community Schools therefore cannot be assured of receiving the requested advancement.

Should the application be successful, funds will be budgeted in the Debt Service Fund to repay this loan beginning in the year 2003. Interest on the loan is expected to be no more than four percent and is likely to be as low as one percent.

Common School Fund advancements differ from School Technology Advancement Account (STAA) loans, which Fort Wayne Community Schools receives on an annual basis. Unlike CSF advancements, STAA advancements are given to all applying school corporations, regardless of their assessed value

A motion was made by Bettye J. Poignard, seconded by Carol J. Coen, that the recommendation concerning the application for Common School Fund Loan be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the appointment of a construction management firm for the North Side High School project:

Appointment of Construction Management Firm – North Side High School Project **RECOMMENDATION:** It was recommended that the Board approve the appointment of Geupel DeMars Hagerman, LLC as construction manager for the North Side High School project. Maximum cost for these services will be \$1,210,000 including reimbursables.

RELATED INFORMATION: The Board of School Trustees held a 1028 Hearing at their October 8, 2001, meeting and approved the North Side High School renovation and addition project.

Six Indiana construction management firms provided a proposal and two were selected for interviews. The committee recommended the firm of Geupel DeMars Hagerman, LLC serve as construction manager for the North Side High School project.

Construction management services provide the owner with coordination of the project team, which is composed of the architect, construction manager, and contractors. The construction manager is the owner's representative, working on their behalf from start to finish, ensuring the project will stay within budget and on schedule.

A motion was made by Donald J. Schaab, seconded by Bettye J. Poignard, that the recommendation concerning the appointment of a construction management firm for the North Side High School project be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the bond underwriter for the North Side High School Project:

Bond Underwriter for North Side High School Project **RECOMMENDATION:** It was recommended that the Board approve the appointment of City Securities Corporation as the bond underwriter for the North Side High School project. Maximum cost of these services will be .30 percent of the bond issue. The proposed bond issue is \$49,750,000 and would result in a fee of \$149,250.

RELATED INFORMATION: Proposals were submitted by Bank One Capital Markets, Inc. of Chicago and by City Securities Corporation of Fort Wayne. Although, the City Securities proposed fee is slightly higher than the Bank One proposal of .284 percent, consideration was given to local presence and additional services offered.

A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Bettye J. Poignard, that the recommendation concerning the appointment of a bond underwriter for the North Side High School project be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the reimbursement resolution for the North Side High School project:

Reimbursement Resolution for North Side High School Project **RECOMMENDATION:** It was recommended that the Board approve a resolution to allow proceeds from a bond anticipation note or bond issue for the North Side renovation project to be used for reimbursement to Fort Wayne Community Schools for North Side renovation project expenses.

RELATED INFORMATION: It was expected that Fort Wayne Community Schools will do a bond issue for the North Side renovation project in the Fall of 2002. In addition, a bond anticipation note may be issued earlier. In the meantime, Fort Wayne Community Schools will expend district funds to

pay for certain aspects of the project, including land, surveys, professional fees, publication of notices and other costs. This resolution will allow proceeds of the future bond to reimburse district funds.

A motion was made by Carl A. Johnson, seconded by Bettye J. Poignard, that the recommendation concerning the approval of a reimbursement resolution for the North Side High School project be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation and related information concerning the application for and acceptance of the Sound Field Systems grant:

Sound Field Systems Grant **RECOMMENDATION:** It was recommended that the board approve the application for and the acceptance of a grant from Hear Indiana, the Association for Children with Hearing Impairment.

RELATED INFORMATION: This competitive grant is used to fund the purchase and installation of 18 sound field units at a cost of \$22,000.00 in classrooms where children with hearing impairment receive instruction. These units are portable, making it easy to change the location as children are promoted from one grade level to the next.

Theresa Oberley, Director of Special Education, and Laura Dettmer resource teacher for students with hearing impairments prepared this grant. The new sound systems will be installed in the following elementary schools: Adams, Brentwood, Croninger, Forest Park, Irwin, Lindley, Scott, St. Joe Central, Weisser Park, and Young. Also, Blackhawk, Kekionga, Lakeside, and Portage middle schools will be recipients.

These funds are used in the advancement intended and outlines in Strategy IX: Technology to Transform Learning and Operations.

A motion was made by Carol J. Coen, seconded by Jon J. Olinger, that the recommendation concerning the Sound Field Systems grant be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

 $\,$ Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation and related information concerning the Title VI grant:

Title VI Grant

RECOMMENDATION: It was recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of funds from the Indiana Department of Education for a Title VI grant in the amount of \$205.805.

RELATED INFORMATION: Title VI funding is provided to schools under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) as amended by the Improving A merica's Schools Act of 1994 (IASA). Allocations are based on enrollments for both public and private/non-public schools in the district. An amount of \$44,842 has been allocated to serve identified non-public schools. FORT WAYNE COMMUNITY SCHOOLS serves as the Local Education Agency for the grant. Curriculum coordinator, Sandy Sunderland-Willis is responsible for this non competitive grant.

Title VI funds will provide inservice training and instructional materials for FORT WAYNE COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

PreK-12 teachers to support the following:

- the elementary Balanced Literacy Model,
- reading and writing development at the secondary level,
- reading and writing in all content areas, and
- professional development linked to P.L. 221 plans.

The grant addresses the advancement intended and outlined in the FORT WAYNE COMMUNITY SCHOOLS Strategic Plan:

Strategy I, Personally Appropriate Education and Strategy V, Staff Effectiveness

A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Bettye J. Poignard, that the recommendation concerning the Title VI grant be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation and related information concerning the Seeds for Tomorrow Grant for Memorial Park Middle School:

Seeds for Tomorrow Grant – Memorial Park Middle School

RECOMMENDATION: It was recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of a grant for \$1,107.80 from the Junior League of Fort Wayne for Memorial Park Middle School.

RELATED INFORMATION: *Seeds for Tomorrow*, is an educational/charitable project of the Junior League of Fort Wayne providing grants for projects to improve communities in Allen County. Grants will be awarded in March of 2002.

Each year, retired Science teacher, Larry Lesh becomes an advisor to a team of four Memorial Park eighth-grade students competing in the Bayer/National Science Foundation (NSF) competition. The competition requires students to identify a problem in the community and address ways to solve that problem. After meeting with community leaders, the team this year chose to educate students and parents about the value of trees in our daily lives and the importance of trees in urban areas (urban forestry). The team will create a video and distribute flyers during presentations to groups of elementary students. Monies from the grant will be used to develop the video, print flyers and stickers, and purchase paper and artwork for billboards in the community. Trees will also be made available for Allen County residents to plant in the park strip.

Larry Lesh is responsible for this competitive grant which addresses advancement intended and outlined in Strategy I, Personally Appropriate Education and Strategy X, Community Linkages.

A motion was made by Carl A. Johnson, seconded by Carol J. Coen, that the recommendation concerning the application for and acceptance of the Seeds for Tomorrow Grant for Memorial Park Middle School be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation and related information concerning the Change in Policy 5460, Graduation Requirements:

Change in Policy 5460, Graduation Requirements **RECOMMENDATION:** It was recommended that the board approve the revision of Policy 5460, GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS. The changes in Policy 5460 are intended to permit special education students to receive a Certificate of Graduation rather than a Certificate of Completion, as they currently receive.

RELATED INFORMATION: This policy revision was requested by parents of special education students who are on the non-diploma track due to the nature of the students' disability. These students will have completed the requirements set forth by their case conference committees, and will have demonstrated competencies and skills that are a substantial challenge for them. While diplomas will not be awarded, the policy revision will permit students to receive Certificates of Graduation, which more accurately describes the students' success. The policy will also permit the students to participate in commencement exercises.

A motion was made by Carl A. Johnson, seconded by Bettye J. Poignard, that the recommendation concerning the approval and acceptance of the change in Policy 5460, Graduation Requirements be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.
