A motion was made by Kurt A. Walborn, seconded by Kweku Akan, that the minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees held January 9, 2006, be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Wendy Robinson, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

Staff Spotlight –  
Deb Silva, Bus  
Driver

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board recognize Deb Silva, a bus driver for North Side High School for her hard work and dedication to Fort Wayne Community Schools.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** The Staff Spotlight program is the district's method of recognizing employees for outstanding work and commitment to excellence.

We honored Deb Silva, a FWCS employee for 13 years. Each school day, she works to insure on-time, safe delivery of her students to school and on their return home in the afternoon.

Deb provides transportation to students who represent a variety of cultures. At times, she considers learning new bus routes to be challenging. But most of all, Deb admits she is rewarded each time the students tell her how they enjoy riding, or when parents send notes and cards telling her how safe they feel that their children are on her bus.

A video highlighting her accomplishments was shown.

Vouchers

Dr. Robinson presented the vouchers for the period ending January 11, 2006, with the recommendation the vouchers be approved. A motion was made by Kurt A. Application  
for Common  
School Fund  
Loan

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Application for Common School Fund Loan:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of an advancement from the Indiana Common School Fund for educational technology equipment for 2006 in the amount of \$1,950,000.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** Advancements from the Common School Fund provide funds for school districts to purchase educational technology. The Fort Wayne Community Schools (FWCS) will use these moneys to help fund the FWCS technology plan previously submitted to the state. Technology funds are currently insufficient to fund all the technology needs of the school corporation.

Funds are provided as a loan and are awarded to school corporations on the basis of assessed value (AV) per pupil, with low AV per pupil school corporations receiving funds before high AV per pupil corporations. FWCS therefore cannot be assured of receiving the requested advancement.

Should the application be successful, funds will be budgeted in the Debt Service Fund to repay this loan beginning in the year 2007. Interest on the loan is expected to be no more than four percent and is likely to be as low as one percent.

Common School Fund advancements differ from School Technology Advancement Account (STAA) loans, which FWCS receives on an annual basis. Unlike CSF advancements, STAA advancements are given to all applying school corporations, regardless of their assessed value per pupil ranking.

2005 Transfer of Appropriations Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the 2005 Transfer of Appropriations:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the 2005 General Fund and Preschool Fund budgeted appropriations be revised as indicated on the attached listing.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** At the Board meeting on December 12, 2005, the administration was granted authority to transfer and adjust appropriations as deemed necessary prior to the close of business for December. The administration is now requesting that the Board ratify the necessary transfers and adjustments of appropriations.

At the beginning of each year, the school corporation receives a budget order from the State Board of Tax Commissioners that sets the appropriations for each major spending classification. During the course of administering the budget, expenditures are charged to designated expenditure accounts as recommended by the State Board of Accounts. At the close of each year, it has been customary to recommend transfers of appropriations between major programs. Authority for the Board to transfer appropriations is contained in Indiana Code 6-1.1-18-6.

Transferring appropriations allows the administration to adjust appropriations in response to unanticipated needs and/or changing priorities while staying within the constraints of the overall budget.

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Emergency Temporary Loan:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve an emergency temporary loan from the General Fund to the Pension Bond Debt Service Fund in the amount of \$65,710.89 on December 31, 2005. Repayment of the loan will occur by June 30, 2006.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** Property tax and excise tax revenue distributions in 2005 were short of budget. This shortfall resulted in a deficit cash balance in the Pension Bond Debt Service Fund at December 31, 2005. State statute permits temporary loans between property tax supported funds to enhance a fund that is need of money for cash flow purposes.
