Board of Finance

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board of School Trustees officers are also named the officers of the Fort Wayne Community Schools Board of Finance according to the Board's bylaws. It is recommended the 2014 investment report is reviewed.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** State law requires that a Board of Finance meeting be conducted in January of each year. At the meeting, the Board of Finance is required to name officers and to review an annual investment report and the investment policy of the district.

BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES FORT WAYNE COMMUNITY SCHOOLS CORPORATION FINANCES 6144/page 1 of 1

#### 6144 INVESTMENT INCOME

The School Board authorizes the Treasurer or a Deputy Treasurer to make investments from the several funds of the Corporation in:

- A. bonds, bills, or notes of the United States; obligations, the principal and interest of which are fully guaranteed by the United States; or obligations of the State;
- B. certificates of deposit issued by financial institutions organized and authorized to operate in this State;
- C. repurchase agreements; or
- D. all other securities that meet the criteria of State law.

The purpose of the investments is to maximize the returns on the Corporation's fund balances consistent with the safety of those monies and the desired liquidity of the investments.

All investments must mature or be redeemable within the period stated by law but in no case in excess of two (2) years.

The Corporation may contract a depository for the operation of a cash management system under the following conditions:

- A. the contract is in writing;
- B. the contract provides for the investment of funds by the depository;
- C. the depository keeps all records concerning the cash management;
- D. the investments are made in accordance with State law with maturities not to exceed two (2) years; and
- E. the contract, which cannot exceed two (2) years, is awarded using the Corporation's purchasing procedure.

Money in the several funds of the School Corporation may be commingled for the purpose of making an investment. Investment income will be receipted into the General Fund, unless the law or a separate Board arrangement dictates otherwise.

DIBELS for Accountability Decisions (AD) Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the DIBELS for Accountability Decisions (AD):

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve a 3-year contract with Amplify for grades 3-5 for DIBELS for Accountability Decisions (AD) in the amount of \$202,600.70. The contract covers the 2014-15, 2015-16, and 2016-17 school years.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** DIBELS for Accountability Decisions (AD) is an add-on to the DIBELS assessment that is currently being used by teachers to assess reading skills from kindergarten through grade 5. The add-on enables schools to meet the accountability requirements of the Teacher Incentive Fund (TIF) Grant and was recommended by the U.S. Department of Education.

The Amplify contract is being funded by the TIF Grant for grades 3-5. The Indiana Department of Education funds kindergarten through grade 2. Amplify is the sole source provider for DIBELS AD.

Questions will be answered by Laura Cain, Assistant to the Superintendent for Strategic Initiatives.

#### Transportation Recommnendation

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Appointment of Common Wage Committee:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the following Transportation recommendations:

- Reduce transportation to conform to Policy: Operations 8600.01
- Three Tier Bell Schedule
- Feeder Adjustments

**RELATED INFORMATION:** Due to the effect of property tax caps on revenue with rising costs, it has become necessary to reduce transportation services. This recommended plan is necessary to achieve this reduction.

According to Board Policy 8600.01 students are eligible for transportation if they reside beyond the following radius: 1-mile elementary; 1.5 miles middle school; and 2 miles for high school.

Beginning with the 2015-16 school year, a three tier bell schedule will be implemented:

Dr. Robinson encouraged parents to attend Parent Teacher Conferences next week and that all students are to have a completed Assignment Application for 2015-16 to assist in having accurate staffing and transportation routes.
