RELATED INFORMATION: Kekionga Middle School was built in 1960 and much of the original steam-heating system is still in place. This project replaces all mechanical equipment from steam to hot water. The replacement includes energy efficient hot water boilers, hot water piping sized for cooling, univents sized for cooling, hot water pumps, HVAC equipment, energy management system, fire alarm, and all new windows. This recommendation is within the project budget, which is funded from the Capital Projects Fund. Project specifications require the work to be substantially completed by August 4, 2005.

Short-Term Disability

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Short-Term Disability:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board renew Standard Security Life Insurance Company as the short-term disability carrier for a two-year term, effective February 1, 2005 through January 31, 2007.

RELATED INFORMATION: Standard Security has provided Fort Wayne Community Schools' short-term disability coverage since February 1, 2002, and has established a good service record over the past three years. They have offered to renew the FWCS plan at a rate of \$.39 per \$10.00 of coverage. This is a savings of 9.3% from the previous rate of \$.43.

Quotes were solicited from three other companies. One company quoted a rate significantly higher than the renewal offer from Standard Security. One company provided the same rate and a similar two-year guarantee. One company, American United Life, did provide a slightly lower rate of \$.38 but only for a one-year period. Their two-year rate was significantly higher than that offered by our current provider and would not provide the same cost savings opportunity.
