Approval of Minutes – January 23, 2006 A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Kurt A. Walborn, that the minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees held January 23, 2006, be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Wendy Robinson, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

Staff Spotlight – Barbara Hole, Cafeteria Manager – Memorial Park Middle School **RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board recognize Barbara Hole, Cafeteria Manager at Memorial Park Middle School, for her contributions to the students, staff and faculty of Fort Wayne Community Schools.

RELATED INFORMATION: The Staff Spotlight program is the district's method of recognizing employees for outstanding work and commitment to excellence.

We honored Barbara Hole, an FWCS employee for 20 years. Barbara has worked all 20 years at Memorial Park. She started as a cafeteria assistant and quickly worked her way up to cafeteria manager. She oversees all daily operations, such as staff management, menu planning, food preparation, and financial record keeping. Barb has a real love for children. She always goes the extra mile to make sure her team of cafeteria assistants work together to make lunch time an enjoyable experience for all. Her biggest challenge is trying to serve 640 students daily as efficiently as possible every day. She feels rewarded however, when the students and staff give her a smile of appreciation. She would like to repay the favor by establishing her own scholarship to be awarded to a female high school senior planning to attend Ball State University to earn a degree in education. She has requested that the student rank in the upper 10 percent of her class. In addition, applicants will be screened on the basis of financial need, leadership, scholarship and initiative. The FWCS Scholarship Committee will make the final selection in awarding the scholarship, which will be for \$1,000 renewable for four years.

Global Positioning Systems Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Global Positioning Systems:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve purchasing 152 Global Positioning Systems (GPS) from:

Synovia Indianapolis, IN \$186,960.00

RELATED INFORMATION: A study was conducted by the Transportation Department over several years to evaluate Global Positioning Systems (GPS) and their functional use for student transportation. In 2004, Synovia was determined by the Transportation Department to be the vendor that best met FWCS needs. A pilot project was initiated and GPS units were installed on 30 of our active buses. The pilot was successful and led to the installation of GPS units on 35 more buses during the past year.

The information received from the pilot units has been invaluable. FWCS not only knows where a bus is located but can also better answer questions from parents, such as when their student's bus is estimated to arrive. Safety issues such as the speed the bus has traveled, the stops that have been made, and the exact times of all bus activities are readily available. The ability to precisely pinpoint the location of a bus in the event of a breakdown ensures a timely replacement and the least amount of time for students to be inconvenienced.

The purchase of the GPS units is being made directly from the manufacturer, Synovia. Due to software compatibility requirements, Synovia is the sole source for their product. Indiana law does not require a bid for sole source purchases when the compatibility of equipment, accessories, or replacement parts is a substantial consideration in the purchase, and only one source meets the using agencies reasonable requirements (I.C. 5-22-10-8).
