**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve a contract to provide professional environmental consulting and field services with respect to an underground fuel oil storage tank located at Pleasant Center School.

SES Environmental \$24,000

It is further recommended that the Board declare that an emergency exists at Pleasant Center School and that \$24,000 from the emergency account in the Capital Projects Fund be allocated for the payment of items related to the removal of the abandoned underground storage tank.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: The underground fuel oil storage tank at Pleasant Center is emitting odors and it is probable that it has developed a leak. Therefore, we must remove the tank and remediate the area. The following tasks are anticipated for this work: screening of ambient air in classrooms, removal and disposal of fuel stained surface soil, removal and disposal of fuel product in tank, spill response reporting, removal and disposal of tank, tank closure assessment sampling and testing, further soil removal and disposal as needed, tank closure reporting, and environmental investigation. The closure assessment will be conducted in accordance with Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) underground storage tank (UST) guidelines.

Planning and scheduling are under way so that the work can begin immediately.

A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Mitch Sheppard, that the recommendation concerning the Pleasant Center Underground Storage Tank Removal be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Classified Substitute Pay Rate Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Classified Substitute Pay Rate:

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve the Classified Substitute pay scale which includes substitute school assistants, clerical staff, special education assistants, nurses and cafeteria workers.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: Classified substitute employees provide valued support to schools in the absences of regular workers. The lack of substitute assistance, particularly in the classroom, impacts the individual unit's ability to complete required tasks. For a number of years, the rate of pay for substitute school assistants, clerical staff, special education assistants, nurses and cafeteria workers has not attracted nor retained quality substitute employees willing to work in a variety of locations.

The below chart designates that the substitute pay rate will be the lowest hourly rate provided to regular classified employees in the same work categories. This will provide a small increase to their current rate of pay and will be adjusted automatically as compensation is negotiated with representative employee groups.

T TEMPORARY POSITION

**RELATED INFORMATION**: Funds from this grant will be used to integrate classrooms where special education teachers along with general education teachers, trained to utilize differentiation, meet the needs of all students. This mini-grant is available to middle schools participating in the INSIG program in which Lane has participated for four years. Professional development and training will be provided for the teachers involved. Funds will also be used to purchase materials to support the program in the classrooms. Lane Middle School Special Education teacher Lee Murphy, Interventionist Carrie Kennedy, and Administrative Intern Ingrid Laidroo have written, and are responsible for this competitive grant.

This program supports advancement intended and outlined in FWCS District Goal: *Achieve and Maintain Academic Excellence*.
