**RELATED INFORMATION:** Bids were received on February 13, 2006. Five contractors submitted bids. The project award is within the approved budget funded from the Capital Projects Fund.

The project includes fire alarm upgrades, removal of several walls to enlarge existing classrooms, new flooring, VCT and carpet, and some mechanical and plumbing changes. A unit price for door and frame replacement was required as part of this bid. A minimum of 20 doors will be replaced due to fire code requirements. As a part of this contract, a fenced play area will be created on existing asphalt. This is in preparation for converting Geyer Middle School into Towles Intermediate School for the 2006 – 2007 school year.

Planning and scheduling are under way so that construction can begin April 17, 2006 and be completed by August 4, 2006

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the St. Joseph Community Health Foundation Mini Grant for Health Services:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of a grant in the amount of \$1,500.00 from the St. Joseph Community Health Foundation to provide assistance in purchasing emergency equipment and supplies for asthmatic and diabetic students.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** Funds used from this grant will support protocols already in place in Fort Wayne Community Schools. Last year, Fort Wayne Community Schools had more than 3,000 students enrolled who were diagnosed with asthma. This disease is a leading reason for school absences and at its worst, asthma symptoms can be sudden and life threatening. Prior to establishing our emergency asthma protocol in 2004, the only option school nurses had for students with no emergency inhaler, was to call 911.

The number of diabetic students in our district continues to increase. We presently have 98 diabetic students enrolled in our schools. Timely identification of low and high blood sugars can prevent serious or even life threatening complications to our students.

The contact person for this non-competitive grant is Mary Hess, RN, BSN, Health Services Specialist.

This program supports the advancement intended and outlined in Strategy 2: *We will provide a positive culture for students and staff.*
