2014-15 Special Education Grants Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the 2014-15 Special Education Grants:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of special education grants from the Indiana Department of Education for the 2014-15 school year.

RELATED INFORMATION: The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, IDEA 2004, requires that after the base payment allocations are provided, additional funding is awarded to each district based on public and private school enrollment within the local school jurisdiction and according to the number of children living in poverty (National School Lunch Act participants). Funds are used to support salaries and fringes of approximately 145 staff members. These non-competitive grants are in addition to the special education foundation payment.

The Part B Special Education Grant amount for FWCS for the 2014-2015 school year is \$8,183,026.00, an increase of \$35,948.00 from last year. The Preschool Special Education Grant amount is \$285,937.00, a decrease of \$3,165.00 from last year.

These non-competitive grants are managed by Ann Barnes-Smith, Director of Special Education, and support District Goal I: Achieving and Maintaining Academic Excellence.
