Approval of Minutes – February 24, 2003

Dr. Thomas Fowler-Finn, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

Koshimae Exchange Program **RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board recognize students from Takaoka, Japan, who are visiting Snider High School through the Koshimae Exchange Program.

RELATED INFORMATION: The students' 18-day visit is part of the Koshimae Exchange Program, which provides a cultural exchange between students in Takaoka and Fort Wayne. The five students and one teacher arrived in Fort Wayne for their 18-day visit on March 5, 2003. They visited FWCS schools, met with students and toured Fort Wayne attractions.

Anthis Career Center -Aviation Technology/ Maintenance Program

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the addition of an Aviation Technology Program at the Anthis Career Center.

RELATED INFORMATION: The Anthis Career Education Program, the Pittsburgh Institute of Aeronautics, and the Fort Wayne-Allen County Economic Development Alliance will collaborate to offer a proficiency based two year program leading to a professional powerplant (engines and related systems) certification. At this point there are 14 additional community partners (see attached list) who have given time, money, materials and expertise in order to make this community vision a reality.

This FAA approved curriculum will prepare students to pass the national professional powerplant certification test. Students will gain a clear understanding of the requirements, knowledge and skills necessary to become candidates for jobs in the aviation maintenance industry. Students who continue their education at the postsecondary level will be able to achieve a second certification in aviation airframe maintenance and an associate degree after one year.

This program supports the advancement intended and outlined in Strategy I, Personally Appropriate Education and Strategy X, Develop and Maintain Significant Linkages with Community Resources.

Authorization of Superintendent to Issue Employee Notifications Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Authorization of Superintendent to Issue Employee Notifications:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board authorize the Superintendent to terminate or non-renew, as appropriate, employee contracts and issue layoff notices to other personnel as necessary to effectuate personnel reductions required to reduce personnel expenditures for the 2003-2004 school year to recommended levels.

RELATED INFORMATION: The school corporation, in order to bring expenditures in line with anticipated revenues, must reduce personnel and other expenses. While many of the reductions will be covered in the 2004 budget, it is necessary to start the reduction of staff at the end of this school year. This request for authority will permit the Superintendent to accomplish those reductions required to prevent a general fund shortfall of approximately \$4.5 million in 2003 and \$13.3 million in 2004 if the state passes a flatline budget for education.
