Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Approval of Contract with Fort Wayne Education Association

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve revisions to the Master Contract agreed to between the Board of School Trustees of Fort Wayne Community Schools (FWCS) and the Fort Wayne Education Association (FWEA).

**RELATED INFORMATION:** On Thursday, March 11, 2010, FWCS and FWEA reached a tentative agreement on a one-year contract including calendars. The 2007-2009 contract expired August 18, 2009, and has been status quo since expiration.

A summary of the contract revisions include:

1. A Memorandum of Agreement covering the staffing process of the eleven LEAD schools; the Memorandum establishes that the selection process is determined by FWCS based upon a commitment to the school and demonstrated teaching effectiveness, without seniority or placement of teachers who do not meet the criteria. Incentives for the selected teachers are also included, but are contingent on funding.
2. A Memorandum of Agreement establishing three joint committees:
  - the first is to monitor the LEAD schools next year and recommend adoption of effective practices in the remaining FWCS schools;
  - the second is to develop a new evaluation system to be implemented in the LEAD schools next fall as well as study the rest of the RttT/state requirements for turning around schools and recommend contract changes for the next agreement to bring it into compliance; and
  - the third is to study pay and benefits for changes second semester next school year.
3. Contract changes:
  - increase high school class sizes to accommodate the revised high school schedule change to seven periods from four;
  - increase the student instructional day;
  - change the teacher work day to decrease late busses; and
  - give some relief to special education teachers revising student IEP's for a second time in a school year due to the student's transition to a different school the following year.

A motion was made by Stephen Corona, seconded by Mitch Sheppard, that the recommendation concerning the Approval of Contract with Fort Wayne Education Association be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.
