Approval of Minutes – March 10, 2003

Dr. Thomas Fowler-Finn, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

3000th Super Senior Card Recipient **RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board recognize the 3,000th participant in the Super Senior Card program.

RELATED INFORMATION: The Super Senior Card was initiated in January 1996 for senior citizens who live in the Fort Wayne Community Schools district. The card provides free admission to athletic and fine arts events and discounts to Continuing Education classes.

As the 3000th participant, Karen Wild will receive a free class of her choice in the Neighborhood Connection program, an FWCS mug, and our thanks for her participation in this program.

M.A.T.H. Competition Irwin Elementary **RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board recognize students from Irwin Elementary School their 1st-place finish at the Math Academic Teams for Hoosiers competition.

RELATED INFORMATION: The competition included four rounds in which students had to answer multiple-choice questions based on the 2000 Academic Standards for Mathematics.

Irwin's team scored 24 out of a possible 28 points in the annual competition. The team competed against 76 other schools in the Class 4 division. Irwin placed 4th out of the 299 teams that competed overall.

ISTEP Cut Score Process **RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board recognize Sara Zuber, math facilitator at Scott Elementary School; Marge Goyings, a teacher at Shawnee Middle School; Derrell Gatson, a teacher at Memorial Park Middle School; Sandra Sunderland-Willis, curriculum coordinator and Susan Brace, a teacher at Jefferson Middle School and a member of the Indiana State Board of Education for taking part in the bookmarking phase of the ISTEP+ cut score process.

RELATED INFORMATION: Sara Zuber, Marge Goyings, Derrell Gatson and Sandra Sunderland-Willis were among 144 Indiana educators chosen to take part in this process in January. Each educator met for three days with 23 other Indiana educators to help identify recommendations for cut scores. Their work focused directly on Indiana's students and their performances on the ISTEP+ relative to Indiana's new academic standards.

As a member of the Indiana Board of Education, Susan Brace began the cut score setting process by creating definitions for "pass" and "pass plus." Those definitions gave the 144 educators a framework to begin the process.

Staff Spotlight -Sally Butler, teacher, Memorial Park Middle School **RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board recognize Sally Butler, social studies teacher at Memorial Park Middle School for her contributions to the children and families of Fort Wayne Community Schools.

RELATED INFORMATION: The Staff Spotlight program is the district's method of recognizing employees for outstanding work and commitment to excellence. We honor Sally Butler who brings US history to life for eighth grade students at Memorial Park Middle School. Through reenactments, costumes and character roles, her classes capture the excitement, the mystery, and the drama of years gone by. A well-know authority on Lincoln and the Civil War period, she holds the distinction of serving on the board of the Lincoln Museum – something no other teacher has been invited to do. A video highlighting her accomplishments was shown.

This program addresses advancement intended and outlined in Strategy V, Ensuring Staff Effectiveness, and Strategy VIII, Communicating that FWCS is an Excellent School System.

Whitney Young Early Childhood Center Report

Whitney Young Early Childhood Center offers preschool and kindergarten children a learning environment designed to help them become self-starting, participatory learners. The Reggio Emilia approach offered in this unique center has been proven effective in establishing connections in the brain that promote deeper and more profound understanding of key concepts. Principal Diana Parker talked about the successes of this approach. A video was shown.

Reading First Grant

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Reading First Grant:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve application for and acceptance of the Reading First Grant for the fiscal year 2003 in the amount of \$969,880 from the Indiana Department of Education.

RELATED INFORMATION: This competitive grant was written by members of the Curriculum Department and Dr. Patsy Turnipseed

The grant, awarded by the U.S. Department of Education under the No Child Left Behind Act, is a six-year grant for grades K-3. The Reading First Grant provides grants to state educational agencies to implement findings from scientifically based reading research in schools and classrooms. Indiana received \$10 million. Schools were selected for this grant based on poverty level and ISTEP + test data. The schools selected for this grant are: Franke Park, Indian Village, Irwin, Maplewood, Northcrest, and Weisser Park.

The purpose of the grant is to ensure all children will read on or above grade level by the end of third grade. The funding will support a language arts instructional facilitator at each building, job embedded and summer professional development, and materials and supplies. Money allocated for materials and supplies will be used to purchase required assessments, books, and balanced literacy supplies.

The grant addresses advancement intended and outlined in Strategy IV, Articulated and Coordinated Curriculum, and Strategy V, Staff Effectiveness.
