RELATED INFORMATION: One of the tasks of each FWCS Board member is to recommend an appointment to the FWCS Scholarship Committee. The Scholarship Committee was established by the Board of School Trustees on September 24, 1984, and each spring since 1987, scholarships have been awarded to FWCS students. Germany Field Trip – Northrop High School Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Germany Field Trip – Northrop High School:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the field trip proposal for Northrop High School students to visit Gera, Germany in June 2007.

RELATED INFORMATION: Northrop High School has enjoyed a sister-school relationship with the Goethe Gymnasium in the sister-city of Fort Wayne, Gera, Germany for 14 years. In June 2007, 8-15 German language students would like to reciprocate the latest visit from Gera in October 2006. They would be accompanied by their German teacher, Mr. Kris Kallmeyer, a veteran of five previous exchanges, and several chaperoning parents.

Plans are to leave Indiana during the first week of June immediately after the end of school and return three weeks later. Exact dates are pending the confirmation of flights and snow days. During the trip, students will stay in Gera with host families of students attending the Goethe Gymnasium. While there, they will attend normal classes with their host siblings. Excursions to Dresden, Eisenach, Leipzig, Weimar, the concentration camp Buchenwald, as well as overnight excursions to Frankfurt and Berlin are planned and students will stay in youth hostels.

The opportunity to participate will be extended to all non-freshmen students of German with strong preference given to those who will have had at least two years of German by the departure date and who have at least a "B" average in German. Students will have to submit a written application explaining why they want to participate. The cost will be under \$2000.00 for everything with portions being offset by fundraising and sponsorships.

Kris Kallmeyer is responsible for the planning of this field trip. Barbara Ahlersmeyer is the principal.

Foellinger Foundation Grant – Summer Voyage Program

Based on student's reading level, children will be able to attend the program offered at six elementary schools (Brentwood, Harrison Hill, Holland, Indian Village, Lindley, and Scott). Each grade level has a separate theme that will guide the literacy activities during the program.
