Future City Competition

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board recognize the students from Blackhawk Middle School for the awards they won at the regional Future City Competitions held in January at IPFW.

RELATED INFORMATION: The Future City Competition is an educational program for middle school students sponsored by the National Engineer's Association. It combines a stimulating engineering challenge with a hands-on application to present the team's vision of a city of the future. RELATED INFORMATION: This system will replace the current Nortel Private Branch Exchange (PBX) phone system that was purchased starting in 2001. The proposals were evaluated on overall proposal suitability, organizational experience, previous work experience including current client references, technical experience, responsiveness to RFP requirements, financial stability, and pricing. Request for Proposals were sent to 18 vendors and ten responded. After a Best and Final Offer process, Frontier was determined to be the most responsible and responsive proposer.

The cost is a 5-year cost for the system that includes installation and yearly maintenance. The project will be funded with the General Fund.
