Ratification of Teamsters, Local Union 414 Contract Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Ratification of Teamsters, Local Union 414 Contract:

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board ratify a contract agreement between Fort Wayne Community Schools and Teamsters, Local Union 414.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: On Sunday, April 25, 2010, Teamsters ratified a tentative agreement for bus drivers. All economics are unchanged from those in effect the last two years, except that insurance and benefits automatically re-open for negotiation in the event there is any change in the district benefit for other groups.

Other changes are as follows:

- Drivers who are members of the bargaining unit at the date of ratification and Board approval, or
  who become members, must remain members of the Union until the expiration of the agreement.
   Drivers who desire to relinquish membership must do so within fifteen days of the active date of
  the agreement. Nothing herein shall require any driver to join the union.
- Evaluations as needed based upon employee performance, and may be conducted at any time. Probation period may be extended up to a maximum of 90 days.
- Grievance timelines have been shortened and limits proceeding to arbitration for work rule violations resulting in no loss of pay.
- Bus route assignment bidding and timelines have been amended.
- Change from calendar to fiscal year for pay and benefit calculation.

Speaker

Mr. Jim Hansel spoke on behalf of the bus drivers to thank Board members and the administration for the work and cooperation put into bringing the contract for a vote.

A motion was made by Kevin Brown, seconded by Becky Hill, that the recommendation concerning the Ratification of Teamsters, Local Union 414 Contract be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Update on Budget Cuts Superintendent Wendy Robinson provided an update on implementing the approved budget cuts. Included in the report were discussions on financial challenges, custodial outsourcing, transition planning for the two schools being closed and teacher lay-offs.

Board members thanked Dr. Robinson and members of the administration for all the work that has been done and continues to be done in these challenging times for FWCS.

Dr. Robinson thanked the staffs at Elmhurst and Pleasant Center and the feeder schools for working with students to have a smooth transition for next year.

Board members also congratulated Kathy for being honored by the Indiana Association of School Business Officials (IASBO) as the School Business Official of the Year.

Kevin Brown and Mark GiaQuinta commented on attending the National School Boards Association conference in Chicago. The FWCS Board presented a session at the conference. Board members who attended, enjoyed the key-note speakers including Wynton Marsalis, Charlie Rose, Jeffry Canada and Diane Ravitch.

There being no further business, upon a motion by Stephen Corona, seconded by Kevin Brown, the meeting was adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
