OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS

Roll Call The Board of School Trustees of the Fort Wayne Community Schools met in regular session in the Lester L. Grile Administrative Center on Monday, April 28, 2008 at 6:02 p.m. President Mark GiaQuinta called the meeting to order with a moment of silence for Lakeside Middle School teacher Sandra Heit who died suddenly of a heart attack and Price Elementary kindergarten student Johnae Bennett who died in a house fire. Approval of Minutes – April 14, 2008 A motion was made by Carol J. Coen, seconded by Jon J. Olinger, that the minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees held April 14, 2008, be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Vouchers Dr. Douglas Coutts, standing in for Superintendent Robinson, presented the vouchers for the period ending April 28, 2008, with the recommendation the vouchers be approved. A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Carol J. Coen, that the vouchers appearing in the listing dated April 28, 2008, be approved without exception. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Main Network Switches for Schools Dr. Coutts presented the following recommendation concerning the Main Network Switches for Schools:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve purchasing CISCO 3750 Network Switches from NE Tech for the amount of \$279,184.20.

RELATED INFORMATION: This purchase will replace all network switches at Grile, Anthis, Construction Trades, and Automotive buildings. These switches have a 1 gigabit bandwidth maximum and replace the 10/100 megabit switches purchased in 2001.

The switches were publicly bid (BD-100018); however, all bids were over the allocated budget and were rejected. After further discussion with the lowest bidder, we were able to obtain pricing from CISCO at 4% below Indiana Quantity Purchase Agreement (QPA) pricing. The switches are a part of the 2008 Technology Capital Projects Fund budget.

This recommendation supports District Goal III: *Operate with fiscal responsibility, integrity and effectiveness.*

2008 Traffic & Site/Safety PPI Project

Dr. Coutts presented the following recommendation concerning the 2008 Traffic & Site/Safety PPI Project:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the following construction contract for traffic and site/safety projects at 13 sites:

Wayne Asphalt and Construction Co., Inc.

Base Bid \$480,000

(Adams, Construction Trades, Fairfield, Glenwood Park, Indian Village, Jefferson, Lane, Maplewood, Miami, North Transportation, Pleasant Center, South Transportation, and Waynedale)

Contract Total \$480,000

RELATED INFORMATION: Improvements to bus lanes at Adams, Indian Village, and Miami, along with improvements of parent drop-off areas at Glenwood Park and Waynedale are a part of this project. Asphalt replacement and overlays at Jefferson, Maplewood, North and South Transportation Centers, and Construction Trades are also included. The projects are part of the Capital Projects Fund plan and are within budget. Project specifications require the work to be completed by August 1, 2008.

Tech Prep
Grant –
Project Lead
the Way –
Northrop
High School

Dr. Coutts presented the following recommendation concerning the Tech Prep Grant – Project Lead the Way – Northrop High School:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of a start-up grant, in the amount of \$20,000 for Project Lead the Way for Northrop High School. Funding comes from Federal Tech Prep Funds distributed by the Indiana Department of Workforce Development.

RELATED INFORMATION: Project Lead the Way is a nationally recognized program that will provide students the opportunity to pursue interest in multiple engineering and other high-tech fields through exploration of career opportunities, internships, and hands-on learning. This program will prompt students to earn Work Ethic Certification, dual credits at IPFW and Ivy Tech, and will better prepare them to select a field of engineering in which to earn a baccalaureate and other advanced degrees and certifications. It will meet the academic standards of the State of Indiana in mathematics, science, technology education and English language arts. The course has been aligned with the prescribed standards in all four areas.

Project Lead the Way will provide students with a skill base to enter post secondary schools prepared to successfully complete collegiate programs in high tech or engineering. It will also be able to fully implement a much needed pre-engineering program that will meet the diverse needs of the students at Northrop High School. Raytheon, IPFW, and Ivy Tech are community partners.

This competitive grant was written by Mr. Ron Flickinger, Area Vocational Coordinator, and Barbara Ahlersmeyer, Principal and supports District Goal I: *Achieve and Maintain Academic Excellence*.
