SkillsUSA Indiana Champion

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board recognize the Anthis Career Center students who were state champions in the Indiana SkillsUSA competitions.

RELATED INFORMATION: The SkillsUSA Championships is the showcase for the best career and technical students in the nation. Contests begin locally and continue through the state and national levels. In 2013, there were nearly 6,000 contestants in 98 separate events. Nearly 1,500 judges and contest organizers from labor and management make the national event possible. The philosophy of the Championships is to reward students for excellence, to involve industry in directly evaluating student performance, and to keep training relevant to employers' needs.

This year seven Anthis Career Center students placed 1^{st} or 2^{nd} in the state, qualifying them to compete at the National Conference in June in Kansas City, Missouri. These students are among the top 2% skilled in the nation and had to work their way through a series of local and regional competitions prior to participating in the state contest.

Alternative Education Program 2013-2014 Renewal Grant Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Alternative Education Program 2013-2014 Renewal Grant:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board accept the Alternative Education Grant from the Indiana Department of Education.

RELATED INFORMATION: Funding for the grant is based on the number of full-time equivalent (FTE) students enrolled in the following programs: Allen County Juvenile Center (ACJC), Expectant Mothers Program at Anthis Career Center, L. C. Ward Education Center, and Youth Life Skills. The district received \$168,000.00.

Alternative Education is designed to meet the needs of students who are not succeeding in the traditional educational setting. Students are provided a variety of options that support continued opportunities towards graduation. FWCS alternatives have interventions for student and families that support academic/behavioral growth.

Johnnie Grimes, Pyramid for SuccessTM Coordinator, is responsible for this non-competitive grant which supports Goal I: *Achieve and Maintain Academic Excellence*. Any questions will be answered by Ms. Grimes.

A motion was made by Stephen Corona, seconded by Becky Hill, that the recommendation concerning the Alternative Education Program 2013-2014 Renewal Grant be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Textbook Adoption 2014-2020 and Student Fees 2014-2015 Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning Textbook Adoption 2014-2020 and Student Fees 2014-2015:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board adopt proposed materials for 2014-2020 for use in grades 6-12 English, World Language, Theatre, and grades K-12 English as a New Language. It is also recommended that the Board approve the rental rates for school year 2014–2015.

RELATED INFORMATION: Except for reading, the State Board of Education no longer will produce a list of approved textbooks. Schools can adopt materials that they determine meet the needs of their students. A textbook adoption committee was facilitated by the Curriculum Department. This committee included FWCS teachers from each school and parents who reviewed the instructional materials. Teachers and parents recommended the textbooks that met the standards and the instructional needs of the students for adoption.

Families unable to pay student fees may apply for financial assistance. Currently, students approved for free lunch are also eligible for free textbooks. The State of Indiana reimburses the Fort Wayne Community Schools Textbook Rental Fund for a portion of the textbook rental charges for qualified students and the remainder is supplemented from the General Fund.

The FWCS textbook adoption process addresses district Goal I, *Achieve and Maintain Academic Excellence* and Goal II, *Actively Engage Parents and the Community*.

Questions will be answered Natalie Brewer, Curriculum Director, Karyn Tomkinson, English/Language Arts Coordinator, and Sheryl Merchant, Textbook Rental Coordinator.

A list of the adopted materials and student fees is on file in the Superintendent's office.

A motion was made by Julie Hollingsworth, seconded by Stephen Corona, that the recommendation concerning the Textbook Adoption 2014-2020 and Student Fees 2014-2015 be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Waiver from Implementation of Protected Taxes Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Waiver from Implementation of Protected Taxes:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board request, from the Indiana Department of Local Government Finance, a waiver from implementation of protected taxes.

RELATED INFORMATION: Since the circuit breaker was implemented in 2009, circuit breaker credits have been applied proportionately to all property tax supported funds. Under IC 6-1.1-20.6-9.8, amended in 2013, implementation of protected taxes provisions was to go into effect in 2014 in order to protect debt service funds. Circuit breaker credits attributable to those funds were to be applied to non-debt service funds.

2014 House Enrolled Act 1062 adds IC 6-1.1-20.6-9.9 which allows school corporations with a circuit breaker loss of at least 10% of levy to waive the implementation of protected taxes. This provision is available for 2014, 2015 and 2016.

Comments

Board member Steve Corona shared information about "Let's Give Allen County" a one-day fundraiser sponsored by the Community Foundation of Greater Fort Wayne to raise funds to support five area nonprofits. Mr. Corona also shared information about a Cinco de Mayo celebration/ fundraiser to benefit Latinos Count on Friday, May 2.

Board member Becky Hill expressed her thanks and appreciation to Director of Facilities Darren Hess and his staff for the time and information shared during the Board work session held on April 23.

Board member Julie Holligsworth thanked Shambaugh Principal Shannon Rodgers and Lindley Principal Mary Kinniry for hosting her visits at each school. Ms. Hollingsworth is impressed by the amount of exciting things going on in the schools. Ms. Hollingsworth commented that the State of Washington is the first state to lose their No Child Left Behind waiver because they rejected a teacher evaluation system that uses student test scores.

Board member Lisa Olinger encouraged families to look at the front page of the FWCS website for opportunities for families and to visit schools to see what's happening in FWCS.

Board President Mark GiaQuinta thanked Dr. Robinson and her team, especially Director of Technology Jack Byrd and his team for the good work with the Indiana Department of Education in determining that technology issues would impact ISTEP testing. Students, parents and teachers know that the best decision was made to allow students to complete ISTEP with paper and pencil. The Board supports the decisions made.

Superintendent Robinson reminded the Board that the issues with online testing involved grades 3-8 only, not high school End of Course Assessments. Dr. Robinson expressed appreciation to the State Department of Education for recognizing the problem and being flexible to change the testing procedures. FWCS will work with the Department of Education and CTB McGraw Hill this summer after school ends to determine solutions for the online testing issues.
