Roll Call

The Board of School Trustees of the Fort Wayne Community Schools met in regular session in the Lester L. Grile Administrative Center on Monday, April 28, 2003, at 7:05 p.m. President Stephen Corona called the meeting to order with the following members in attendance:

Approval of Minutes – April 14, 2003 A motion was made by Robert A. Armstrong, seconded by Jon J. Olinger, that the minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees held April 14, 2003, be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Thomas Fowler-Finn, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

World War II Veteran Diplomas **RECOMMENDATION:** We presented high school diplomas to World War II veterans Scott R. Wyatt and Dale H. Scherer. A new federal law that took effect this past July established a method to award a high school diploma to honorably discharged veterans of World Wars I and II. Mr. Wyatt joined the U.S. Navy during his junior year at North Side High School in 1944. Mr. Scherer also joined the U.S. Navy during his junior year at Central High School in 1944.

We are very proud to honor Mr. Wyatt and Mr. Scherer with a high school diploma, one they would have received in 1945 if the war had not intervened. And, we want to thank them for their service to this country.

Mr. Scherer was unable to attend the board meeting. Mr. Wyatt came forward and the superintendent made a presentation.

Elmhurst -State Basketball Championship **RECOMMENDATION:** It was recommended that the Board recognize the boys basketball team at Elmhurst High School for making it to the state basketball championship in Class 3A.

RELATED INFORMATION: The boys basketball team at Elmhurst made it to the state finals for the first time in the school's history. The team competed against Bishop Chatard in the Class 3A championship on March 29 in Indianapolis.

The team ended the season with a 22-6 record and remained in the state's top 10 throughout the season. Two players – James Hardy and Joseph Poindexter – were named to the All-SAC team and Steven Driver received an honorable mention. Head coach Keith Edmonds was named SAC Coach of the Year and Hardy received the Tiffany Gooden Award as the best SAC player this season.

Hardy also was named to the All-State second team and Poindexter received an honorable mention.

RELATED INFORMATION: The Staff Spotlight program is the district's method of recognizing employees for outstanding work and commitment to excellence. We honor Rafael Colon, a Northcrest Elementary School fifth-grade teacher who is tireless in his mission to ensure that all of his students reach their highest academic potential. From attending conferences on his personal time to taking advantage of technology and other resources, he provides his students with meaningful, challenging and engaging lessons and activities every day. He was honored earlier this year as the recipient of the "Unsung Hero/Excellence in Education" award from the Allen County Local Education Fund and ITT Industries. A video highlighting his accomplishments was shown.

This program addresses advancement intended and outlined in Strategy V, Ensuring Staff Effectiveness, and Strategy VIII, Communicating that FWCS is an Excellent School System.

Portage Middle School Report Representatives from Portage Middle School introduced the Plan, Do, Check, Act (PDCA) instructional process. This eight-step process relies on data analysis to drive instructional decisions and is fundamental to the "Standards Based-Data Driven" instructional philosophy at this middle school. Principal Jeff King, Language Arts Team Leader Susan Pape, Math Team Leader Kim Hartman, and LEAD Exploratory Leader Academy Intern Frank Kline explained the Plan, Do, Check, Act process and review the professional development activities utilized to put the program in place.

Vouchers

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the vouchers for the period ending April 16, 2003, with the recommendation the vouchers be approved. A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Robert A. Armstrong, that the vouchers appearing in the listing numbered 03-08 be approved without exception. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Gertrude Jaehn and Dean Shilts Scholarship Gift Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Gertrude Jaehn and Dean Shilts Scholarship Gift:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the acceptance of a \$10,250 gift from the descendents of Gertrude Jaehn Shilts and O. Dean Shilts. The gift will create a scholarship fund for the benefit of North Side High School students.

RELATED INFORMATION: Mrs. Shilts was valedictorian of the North Side class of 1938 and Mr. Shilts was a member of the North Side class of 1941. Mrs. Shilts entered college at the age of 47, earning a master's degree and a teaching position with FWCS. Mr. Shilts was never able to attend college, however, both he and Mrs. Shilts appreciated the importance of higher education. The family requests the North Side guidance staff select the recipients with the input of one of the contributors, Jeanette DeVore. At the family's request, applicants will be screened on the basis of financial need, educational potential, and a willingness to work hard. Preference will be given to students planning to become teachers. The recipient must attend a Fort Wayne college or university.

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Tax Anticipation Warrants:

Tax Anticipation Warrants

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the warrant resolution received from the Indiana Bond Bank authorizing Fort Wayne Community Schools to obtain temporary loans for use in the General Fund, Transportation Operating Fund, Transportation Bus Replacement Fund, Capital Projects Fund, Debt Service Fund, Special Education Preschool Fund, and Racial Balance Fund for 2003.

RELATED INFORMATION: Each year, FWCS borrows money through Tax Anticipation Warrants in expectation of receiving the semiannual distribution of property tax revenue. School districts that borrow to support current operating expenses are authorized to sell Tax Anticipation Warrants that pledge property tax receipts as the source of funds for repayment.

The first step toward issuance of Tax Anticipation Warrants is the passage of a resolution with the stipulations that (1) an emergency exists that requires the borrowing of money; (2) the borrowed money will be repaid in June or December from tax levies collected in 2003; and (3) the amount to be borrowed will not exceed \$55 million for the General Fund, \$12 million for the Transportation Operating Fund, \$2.6 million for the Transportation Bus Replacement Fund, \$5.7 million for the Debt Service Fund, \$17.9 million for the Capital Projects Fund, \$196,000 for the Special Education

Preschool Fund, and \$4.9 million for the Racial Balance Fund. Stating the maximum allowed provides flexibility during this time of uncertain cash flows from the State and County.

On January 23, 2003 FWCS sold warrants to the Indiana Bond Bank, as allowed by Indiana Code 5-1.5 et seq., totaling \$30,925,000. The interest rate for the outstanding warrants is 1.42%. On May 15, 2003 we expect to sell additional warrants totaling \$24,355,820. The additional borrowing is due to the delay in property tax reassessment in Allen County. It is uncertain when the corporation will receive the first property tax distribution in 2003, but County officials advised us to plan for a September 30th distribution.

A motion was made by Carol J. Coen, seconded by Kurt A. Walborn, that the recommendation concerning the Tax Anticipation Warrants be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.
