Title I, Part A Basic and Neglected Grant Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Title I, Part A Basic and Neglected Grant:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of the Title I, Part A Basic and Neglected Grant for 2017-18 from the Indiana Department of Education in the amount of \$11,809,668.43.

RELATED INFORMATION: Title I is a federally funded program designed to enable schools with high concentrations of low-income students to provide opportunities for children to acquire the knowledge and skills in the State content areas and to meet the State performance standards for all children.

Eligibility for Title I services is based on criteria related to family income. FWCS determines target areas based on numbers of students receiving free or reduced lunch and/or direct certified for government benefits. These services impact:

- Twenty-three FWCS schools receive Title I services
- Seventeen FWCS schools have Title I Pre-K programs

- Twenty-six non-public schools receive funds from the 2017-18 Title I Grant students who
 receive free or reduced lunch and live in FWCS Title I school attendance areas but attend nonpublic schools are provided instruction through a resource teacher/tutor, an instructional
 assistant or a service provider
- Homeless FWCS students and two institutions for neglected children receive supplemental educational services.

This grant is managed by Kimberly Brooks, Title I Manager, and supports District Goal I: *Achieve and Maintain Academic Excellence*, District Goal II: *Engage Parents and the Community* and District Goal III: *Operate Effectively with Integrity and Fiscal Responsibility*.

Title I, Part D Delinquent Grant Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Title I, Part D Delinquent Grant:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of the Title I, Part D Delinquent Grant for 2017-18 in the amount of \$173,448.46 from the Indiana Department of Education.

RELATED INFORMATION: Allen County Juvenile Center, Lifeline Youth & Family, and Redwoods delinquent institutions receive funds through the Title I, Part D Delinquent Grant to support instruction and transitional services for clients/students. Instruction is designed to sustain academic growth during residency and to close the achievement gap. Both credit course work and/or tutorial services are available.

This grant is managed by Kimberly Brooks, Title I Manager, and supports District Goal I: *Achieve and Maintain Academic Excellence*, District Goal II: *Engage Parents and the Community* and District Goal III: *Operate Effectively with Integrity and Fiscal Responsibility*.

Agile Mind Educational Holdings, Inc. Agreement Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Agile Mind Educational Holdings, Inc. Agreement:

RECOMMENDATION It is recommended that the Board approve an agreement with Agile Mind Educational Holdings, Inc. to purchase a digital teaching and learning system for Mathematics totaling \$421,300.

RELATED INFORMATION: The Agile Mind Accelerator bundle will provide intensive Math supports to prepare students for an accelerated pathway. The Agile Accelerator will supplement current curriculum to identify and address gaps and to increase mastery of standards for all middle school Math students and students enrolled in Algebra I, Algebra II and Geometry. The agreement includes ongoing intensive professional learning for coaches and teachers and the development of a customized assessment aligned to Indiana standards.

The term of the contract commences spring of 2018 and continues through the end of the 2019-20 school year.

Agile Mind is the sole source provider for this teaching and learning system.

This initiative is focused on improving student achievement and educator effectiveness and supports FWCS District Goal I: *Achieve and Maintain Academic Excellence*. The cost of the agreement will be paid from the General Fund.

Professional Learning Management System – RFP #101362 Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Professional Learning Management System – RFP #101362:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the purchase of a Professional Learning Management System from SkillSoft of Nashua, New Hampshire for \$117,071.

RELATED INFORMATION: In the spring of 2017, FWCS contracted with HRchitect to assist in developing requirements for a Professional Learning Management System for FWCS employees. This system will be used to develop, deliver and track District professional learning activities. A Request for Proposals process was conducted with five vendors submitting proposals. After conducting in-depth evaluations of the proposals, SkillSoft's system, SumTotal, was selected as the best value and was also the lowest cost.

The initial purchase and implementation costs will be paid from the PEER Grant. The subsequent annual maintenance fees of \$43,124 will be paid from the Capital Projects Fund.

Questions will be addressed by Ramona Coleman, Director of Professional Learning, and Jack Byrd, Director of Technology.

Superintendent Robinson also thanked the teachers for all that they do. She reminded we are beginning the math intensive work and the intention in the beginning is not to measure impact but to get hands on the resources. Lastly, she reported the passing of Frances Ganaway. Frances was community person, Rotarian, and a strong supporter of FWCS.

Board President Julie Hollingsworth talked about her participation last week with the Seeing Is Believing tour. It was a great group of 40+ people that took tours of the Parkview Education Center and learned about the many career classes available to our students. Ms. Hollingsworth also spoke of the editorial in the Journal Gazette by Board Member Anne Duff about the privatization of public schools.
