RELATED INFORMATION: Wednesday, February 22, around 3 p.m., Mr. Eley looked out his window and saw Juan Sanchez, an 11-year-old FWCS student, being attacked by two dogs. He headed into the lot, arming himself with a glass bottle he found on the ground. The dogs quickly turned from the boy to the 50-year-old man, biting him on both legs. Fort Wayne Police and Animal Control arrived on the scene. Officers on the scene said that had Mr. Eley not stopped, injuries could have been much worse for the boy.
