### Recognitions

Dr. Wendy Robinson, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

### National Honor Roll for Noetic Learning Math Contest

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board recognize Irwin Elementary School students who achieved National Honor Roll status, placing in the top 10% of the country, in the Noetic Learning Math Contest.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: On April 13, 2015, 43 students from Irwin Math/Science Magnet School competed in the Noetic Learning Math Contest.

Noetic Learning Math Contest is an elementary math problem solving contest held twice a year. For this contest, each student has 45 minutes to complete a 20 question math test. The purpose of participating in the contest is to stimulate students' interest in math and to inspire them to excel in math. More than 24,000 students from 603 schools took the Noetic tests this spring. Rowan Miller scored 100%! Only 99 students out of more than 5,000 fifth graders scored that well, putting Rowan in the top 2% of the United States. Henry Kelley's score was 90% putting him in the top 8% of the United States.

Medicaid Reimbursement, RFP #101101 Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Medicaid Reimbursement, RFP #101101:

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve an award to Public Consulting Group (PCG) to provide Medicaid reimbursement services for a three-year period, effective July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2018.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: Medicaid reimbursement services include speech/language therapy, occupational therapy, physical therapy, social work, and individual psychological evaluations for eligible special education students, as well as special education transportation to access these eligible services. Reimbursed funds will support current special education expenditures that are paid from the General Fund.

PCG of Indianapolis, Indiana provides a web based program that is embedded into the IDOE's Indiana IEP (Individualized Education Plan) web site. Their fee is based on a flat rate of 1% of reimbursed claims for the first year, and 4.5% of reimbursed claims for the second and third years of the contract. Based on 2014 eligible claims submitted, PCG's total three-year fee would be \$93,445. Questions will be answered by Manager of Special Education Renee Buskirk.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: Wayne High School EIFS repairs A large portion of the Exterior Insulation Finish System (EIFS) at Wayne High School that failed will be replaced with a new system utilizing mechanical fasteners. The project will be completed by July 31, 2015.

#### South Side High School coil repair

The cooling coil inside the air handler that supplies air conditioning for the South Side Auditorium has failed. Maintenance and Operations personnel have attempted to repair the coil, but unfortunately it will need to be replaced.

A-F Accountability Report Assistant to the Superintendent for Strategic Initiatives Laura Cain presented a report with information and background on the options available to the State for the A-F accountability.

Board members discussed the following resolution to pause the accountability and consequences of A-F grades for the 2014-15 school year. The resolution will be forwarded to the State Board of Education, the media and other Indiana School Boards.

A-F Accountability Resolution

Fort Wayne Community Schools Board of School Trustees Resolution June 8, 2015

Whereas, the adoption of new ISTEP+ tests and new State instructional standards means that there is no historical data to which the application of the A-F grades for the school year 2014-15 can be tied; and

Whereas, the U.S. Department of Education has offered flexibility in application of its accountability rules given these circumstances; and

Whereas, the State Board of Education may consider possible options for implementation of the 2014-15 A-F accountability grades; and

Whereas, twelve possible options for application of State accountability grades have been proposed and the input of school corporations requested.

Now, therefore, the Board of School Trustees of the Fort Wayne Community Schools believes Option #1--Assign no A-F grade for school year 2014-15 and carry over school year 2013-14 A-F grade and Schools will not be held to State intervention consequences based on the retained 13-14 grade--is the only fair option given the absence of historical test data.

A motion was made by Becky Hill, seconded by Jordan Lebamoff, that the A-F Accountability Resolution be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

### Comments

Board Member Glenna Jehl commented on a lockdown at Blackhawk Middle School today that was resolved without incident. Board Member Anne Duff has two students who attend Blackhawk and she was very confident in the ability of the Blackhawk staff and FWCS to handle the situation and did not feel worried. Dr. Robinson applauded the parents and staff at Blackhawk for keeping things calm and cool.

Board Members Becky Hill and Anne Duff attended several end-of-year programs at schools and were impressed with all programs. FWCS schools are very diverse and the students are respectful and excited for friends receiving awards. Ms. Hill encouraged people to attend "Walk and Talk" a program hosted by Reverend Bill McGill to talk about issues of racism.

Superintendent Robinson commented about the FWCS Teacher of the Year Laura McCoy. Ms. McCoy is a music teacher at St. Joe Central Elementary. Dr. Robinson had a great time attending and participating in Ivy Day at South Side High School and is grateful that the community embraces the school.
