Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Perpetual Multi-Purpose Recreational Trail Easement and Transfer of Parcel at the North Transportation Center and Northrop High School:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board ratify the granting of a perpetual multipurpose recreational trail easement and the transferring of rights of a parcel adjacent to the North Transportation Center and Northrop High School to the City of Fort Wayne, Indiana.

It is further recommended that the Superintendent or her designee be authorized to sign the appropriate documents and take necessary steps to complete the transfer and grant the City of Fort Wayne the temporary license to enter the property for the purpose of constructing a portion of the multi-purpose recreational trail, otherwise known as the Pufferbelly Trail, over and under the easement area.

RELATED INFORMATION: The easement consists of a parcel along the north portion of the west property line of FWCS' North Transportation Center containing 50 square feet or 0.001 acre.

The transfer of rights are to a 50' wide x 11,312.7' long parcel (approximately 1.50 acres) consisting of the east half of a former 100' railroad right of way abandoned by the Penn Central Railroad. The City intends to use this strip of ground to construct a segment of the Pufferbelly Trail. The effect of the quit claim deed is to disclaim any interest FWCS may have in this tract and to facilitate the establishment of title to this strip of ground to the City. State law governing the conveyance of property by a political subdivision allows a political subdivision to execute a deed or other instrument to facilitate the clearance of title. IC 36-1-11-11.

A comparison of prices by item is on file in the Purchasing Department and may be reviewed upon request. Overall, the prices of the recommended bidders reflect a 4% increase of like items when compared to the last bid opened in May 2015.
