Medicaid Reimburse **RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve a one-year contract renewal with Go Solutions Group, Inc. (formerly Mecca-Tech, Inc.) to provide Fort Wayne Community Schools with Medicaid reimbursement services.

RELATED INFORMATION: Reimbursable services include speech/language therapy, occupational therapy, physical therapy, social work, nursing and individual psychological evaluations for eligible Special Education students. Go Solutions Group, Inc. of Lansing, Michigan has provided a web based program for the last four years. No software will be purchased by Fort Wayne Community Schools. Their fee is based on \$0.20 per IEP student and \$0.80 per claim. The funds recovered, about \$200,000 annually, will support current Special Education expenditures paid from the General Fund.

2009 Remediation and Preventive Remediation Grant

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of a grant from the Indiana Department of Education for student remediation and preventive services in the amount of \$517,734.

RELATED INFORMATION: The General Assembly makes additional funds available to school corporations to remediate students who have fallen or are in danger of falling below state proficiency standards. Fort Wayne Community Schools believes students are best served when remediation is offered in a variety of formats and timeframes. The district is requesting \$517,734 for remediation and preventative programs to be implemented beginning in June 2009 and continuing through May 2010. An additional \$258,867 will be provided by the district in matching funds.

Funds from the grant will be used to support remediation and preventative activities during the summer and provide support for the Read 180 program.

The Remediation and Preventive Remediation Grant is a non-competitive entitlement grant which promotes District Goal I: *Achieving and Maintaining Academic Excellence*.
