Temporary Interfund Loan **RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve all interfund loans necessary to eliminate deficits in certain funds of the corporation as of June 30, 2017.

RELATED INFORMATION: Cash deficits in funds of the corporation are not allowed at the end of a fiscal year. Deficits in property tax supported funds could occur if the distribution of property taxes from Allen County is short of expectations. Normal timing differences between revenue and expenditures in the General Fund could cause a temporary deficit. State statute allows temporary transfers between funds if certain requirements are met. The treasurer will make all necessary transfers and report the loans to the Board.

Learning Forward Contract

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Learning Forward Contract:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve a Learning Forward contract totaling \$394,600 for the 2017-18 school year to support the continuation of professional learning.

RELATED INFORMATION: Our partnership with Learning Forward continues to thrive. Learning Forward will continue to focus on working with Cabinet, central office and building-based administrators and instructional coaches to grow professional learning with a focus on Theory of Change, learning designs and implementation district wide.

Instructional Coaches - \$79,400

The District Leadership contract will be paid primarily from the Teacher Incentive Fund (TIF) grant with the Interventionist Learning Community being funded by Coordinated Early Intervening Services (CEIS) funds. The cost of the Coaching contract is paid by the Title II, Part A grant.

K12 Insight Contract

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the K12 Insight Contract:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve a renewal of our existing K12 *Insight* contract. The contract extension covers services relating to Let's Talk! as well as our platform for survey implementation and analysis. This contract will auto-renew each year for a three-year term. The annual cost of the contract is \$130,822 and is funded by the Teacher Incentive Fund (TIF) grant.

RELATED INFORMATION: The survey platform of K12 *Insight* informs the work around professional learning, teacher evaluation and the culture and climate of the district. Other support regarding survey platforms and analysis will continue as needed.

Let's Talk! is a way for school districts to monitor the pulse of the community while giving parents, teachers, staff, students and community members a 24/7 channel for ideas, questions, concerns and praise. Let's Talk! embodies our district's commitment to listening and responding with care. Through the Let's Talk! platform, our district demonstrates authentic communication which includes reading, reflecting on and promptly responding to stakeholder input.

School Technology Advancement Account Application Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the School Technology Advancement Account Application:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and the receipt of advancement from the School Technology Advancement Account in the amount of \$587,540 for the 2017-18 school year.

RELATED INFORMATION: The School Technology Advancement Account provides funds annually for school systems to purchase computer technology for student instruction. The Fort Wayne Community Schools uses these moneys to fund learning and technology plans of schools.

The request of \$587,540 is based on a guideline provided by the state of \$500 for each 25 students. Funds are provided in the form of a loan with a very low interest rate. The last loan under this program had an interest rate of 1%. Funds would be budgeted in the Debt Service Fund to repay this loan beginning in 2019.
