Approval of Minutes –June 23, 2003 A motion was made by Kurt A. Walborn, seconded by Geoff Paddock, that the minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees held June 23, 2003, be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, Robert A. Dr. Wendy Robinson, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

Delayed High School Diploma **RECOMMENDATION:** We presented a high school diploma to World War II veteran Merlin Hubert Doud. A new federal law that took effect last year established a method to award a high school diploma to honorably discharged veterans of World Wars I and II.

Mr. Doud joined the U.S. Navy during his junior year at Central High School in 1943. During his three years of service, he received a Victory medal, American Area Campaign medal and Asiatic Pacific Area Campaign medal – 1 star.

We are very proud to honor Mr. Doud with a high school diploma, one he would have received in 1945 if the war had not intervened. And, we want to thank him for his service to this country.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board recognize three students from Anthis Career Center who participated and placed in national competition at the Skills USA-VICA in Kansas City, and the Health Occupations Students of America in Atlanta.

RELATED INFORMATION: More than 4,000 students from across the country competed in the annual competition of Skills VICA-USA and HOSA. This competition is considered the "showcase" of the best career and technical students in the nation. Contests begin locally and continue through the state competition, before culminating at the national contests.

Anthis Information Technology Academy student Adam Whipp won the national title in Internetworking, which includes written, oral, and practical examinations. RELATED INFORMATION: Snider was one of 40 schools in the state to receive the award, which recognizes music programs for their diverse curriculum and outstanding success during the school year. To earn the award, a high school band must meet several criteria to qualify for state competition, including a first division rating as a district or festival marching band participant, a gold rating in a jazz organization event and at least one soloist and one ensemble group rating.

It is further recommended that items listed on below be withdrawn from the bid because of menu changes, the receipt of government commodities, or the absence of an acceptable bid.

RELATED INFORMATION: This bid is for 382 food items to be used in the school lunch program at the Food Service Center and the 11 cooking kitchens from July 28, 2003 through January 9, 2004. The bid includes such items as fruits and vegetables, meat, and staples such as flour, sugar, and salt. The specifications for this bid indicated that FWCS reserves the right to award bids such that no fewer than ten (10) items are supplied by any one vendor. Gordon Food Service and Stanz Foodservice were

the only vendors to bid on the majority of the food items. Other vendors responding did not provide competitive pricing or did not meet product specifications.

A comparison of prices by item is on file in the Purchasing Department and may be reviewed upon request.

Bids were mailed to seven prospective bidders with six responding. Of these six, the bid of US Foodservice, Fishers, IN did not meet legal requirements. Troyer Foods, Incorporated, Goshen, IN submitted a "No Bid."

Overall, the prices of the recommended bidders reflect a one percent increase when compared to the last bid opened in November 2002.

It is further recommended that spork (spoon/fork) packs and 5 inch plastic film be withdrawn because of the absence of an acceptable bid.

RELATED INFORMATION: The bid is for a one-year supply of cafeteria disposable products such as plastic and aluminum containers, plastic and polyester film, and spork packs to be used at the Food Service Center.

Invitations to Bid were mailed to twelve prospective bidders with eleven responding. Of these eleven, the bid of Dispoz-O Plastics, Incorporated, Fountain Inn, SC did not meet legal requirements. Par-Pak, Incorporated, Houston, TX, Preferred Packing, Noblesville, IN, and Standardized Foodservice Systems, Mishawaka, IN submitted a "No Bid."

Overall, the prices of the recommended bidders reflect a six percent increase when compared to the last bid opened in June 2002.

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Student Rights and Responsibilities and Behavior Code:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the 2003-2004 Student Rights and Responsibilities and Behavior Code booklet.

RELATED INFORMATION: This document, first created in 1996, was developed to assist schools in providing consistency and fairness in disciplinary matters. This year, minor changes were recommended by the SMART Review committee, comprised of principals and assistant principals.

These changes have also been reviewed and approved by legal counsel. This booklet reflects those changes. They include a revision of rules 8, 9C, 10, 20, and 33.

Revisions for 2003-04

- 1. Page 10: Deletes "Bullying" from Rule 9C.
- 2. Page 10: Changes the consequences for all of Rule 8 PROFANITY/OBSCENITY to 1 to 4 for all grades. Before, the PreK-5 consequences were 1 to 3 with 6-12 at 1 to 4.
- 3. Page 11: Adds to Rule 10: "C. **BULLYING**: The repetitive direct or indirect attack on another student, creating continual fear, distress, and threat of future attacks."

4. Page 13: Rule 29 – adds "destructive device"

"WEAPONS: Possession, purchase, or sale of a knife, weapon, explosive, chemical agent dispenser, **destructive device**, or other object that can reasonably be considered"

Student Rights and Responsibilities and Behavior Code 5. Page 13: Rule 33 – adds

"FIREARMS: Possession of a loaded or unloaded firearm, laser gun, electronic stun gun, or any weapon or device that expels a projectile by the action of an explosive, or having knowledge of another person's intent to violate or violation of this rule and failing to report the information to a school administrator or teacher."

To address the Board's wishes:

- 6. Page 11: Changes "Law Violations" headline to: "Severe Violations" ... remove the first sentence under that section so it should read: "The following severe violations will result in school consequences, the FWCS Security department will be notified, and the police may be contacted. Parents will be notified if possible."
- 7. Page 13: Top of the page, first sentence now reads: "The following **severe** violations may result in...."

Eliminate a typo:

Page 13 – Rule 33 – changes "laser gun" to "taser gun."

A motion was made by Kurt A. Walborn, seconded by Jon J. Olinger, that the recommendation concerning the Student Rights and Responsibilities and Behavior Code be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Emergency Response and Crisis Management Grant Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Emergency Response and Crisis Management Grant:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application and acceptance of an "Emergency Response and Crisis Management" grant from the U.S. Department of Education in the total amount of \$465,449.

RELATED INFORMATION: Fort Wayne Community Schools functions as the legal applicant and fiscal manager for this grant, representing the Allen County School Safety Commission and all of the 94 public schools in Allen County.

The objective is to use the 18-month grant period to increase the pace of systemic change enabling students in Allen County to benefit from increased levels of protection.

Although all schools have benefited from the collaborative participation in the Allen County School Safety Commission, the schools need to further address some of the gaps that exist in emergency preparedness and crisis management plans. The grant will help address these gaps in a unified county-wide plan that would benefit all of the children in Allen County.

The grant will permit: establishing pilot sites, or expanding existing sites to implement bully prevention programs; reviewing, updating and practicing crisis plans at schools; training for school personnel; Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) training for school-community partners; training for commission members; and training in Critical Incident Stress Debriefing for counselors and commission members.

The overarching goal of this project is to bring schools and their community safety partners to the same level of awareness, planning, and practice of guidelines related to all phases of school safety.

This is a competitive grant prepared by Anita Gross, school safety specialist of Southwest Allen County Schools, and John Weicker, director of security for FWCS. It addresses Strategic Plan III: Safe Caring Environment and Strategic Plan X: Community Linkages.
