The Board of School Trustees of the Fort Wayne Community Schools met in regular session in the Lester L. Grile Administrative Center on Monday, July 22, 2002, at 7:05 p.m. President Stephen Corona called the meeting to order with the following members in attendance:

Dr. Thomas Fowler-Finn, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

Indiana
Dental
Association
Award

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board recognize Becky Talati, registered nurse and Health Services specialist for receiving the prestigious Charles W. Gish Award from the Indiana Dental Association.

RELATED INFORMATION: Under Becky Talati's leadership, FWCS Health Services established the enormously popular dental sealant program that served more than 850 children its first year. The program has provided dental sealant for three-fourths of the second- and third-graders in Title 1 schools. Dental teams from the Neighborhood Health Clinics screen students and put sealant on their six-year molars to prevent future tooth decay. The clinic reports that 40 percent of students screened were found to have active tooth decay.

The Indiana Dental Association's Charles W. Gish Award recognizes Hoosiers who have demonstrated outstanding leadership in dental health services and who have made a positive impact or significant improvement in the overall dental health within a given community. More than 2,500 dentists are members of the IDA.

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Voluntary Student Drug Testing:

1) RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board remove from the table the guidelines for a program of voluntary student drug testing.

RELATED INFORMATION: Pursuant to Roberts' Rules of Order the motion to approve a new voluntary student drug testing program requires placement on the agenda from the table. Upon approval of this motion the Board will then be asked to vote on whether to approve the program itself. However, this vote to place the item on the agenda does not indicate approval or disapproval of the item itself.

A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger to remove the recommendation from the table, seconded by Carl A. Johnson, that the recommendation concerning the Voluntary Student Drug Testing be removed from the table. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

2) RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the guidelines for a new program of voluntary student drug testing.

RELATED INFORMATION: Pursuant to Roberts' Rules of Order the same motion and therefore the same program is now under consideration. No changes have been made to the recommendation or the guidelines as yet. A new one-year pilot program with modifications to the guidelines will be brought forward at a future meeting if it is able to be developed in such a way that it addresses concerns raised by the Board.

A motion was made to remove the recommendation from the table by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Carl A. Johnson. that the recommendation concerning the Voluntary Student Drug Testing be removed from the table. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

A motion was made by Carl A. Johnson, seconded by Jerome F. Henry, Sr., that the recommendation concerning the Voluntary Student Drug Testing policy be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, Jerome F. Henry, Sr. and Stephen Corona; nays, Jon J. Olinger, Donald J. Schaab, and Carl A. Johnson. Recommendation for Voluntary Student Drug Testing was defeated.

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the vouchers for the period ending June 26 and July 10, 2002, with the recommendation the vouchers be approved. A motion was made by Donald J. Schaab, seconded by Carl A. Johnson, that the vouchers appearing in the listing numbered 02-13 and 02-14 be approved without exception. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Bid Recommendation for Food, P/B #8000

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Bid Recommendation for Food, P/B #8000:

It is further recommended that items listed on page two be withdrawn from the bid because of menu changes, the receipt of government commodities, or the absence of an acceptable bid.

RELATED INFORMATION: This bid is for 371 food items to be used in the school lunch program at the Food Service Center and the 11 cooking kitchens from July 29, 2002 through January 10, 2003. The bid includes such items as fruits and vegetables, meat, and staples such as flour, sugar, and salt. The specifications for this bid indicated that FWCS reserves the right to award bids such that no fewer than ten (10) items are supplied by any one vendor. Gordon Food Service and Stanz Foodservice were the only vendors to bid on the majority of the food items. Other vendors responding did not provide competitive pricing or did not meet product specifications.

A comparison of prices by item is on file in the Purchasing Department and may be reviewed upon request.

Bids were mailed to eight prospective bidders with six responding.

Overall, the prices of the recommended bidders reflect less than one percent decrease when compared to the last bid opened in November 2001.

It is further recommended that twelve ounce regular and flavored bottled water be withdrawn because of absence of an acceptable bid.

RELATED INFORMATION: The bid is for a one-year contract, with an option to extend annually for each of the next four years, to supply beverages to FWCS schools and facilities. Good nutrition is Food and Nutrition Services' primary goal. More stringent specifications are being used this year for beverages to be served in schools through Food and Nutrition Services. Beverages containing nutrients are preferred in making award determinations. The nutrients considered are Vitamin A, Vitamin C, calcium, niacin, thiamin, riboflavin and iron.

Invitations to Bid were mailed to eight prospective bidders with six responding. Of these six, Coca Cola Bottling Company, Fort Wayne, IN and Midwest Vending & Beverage Company, Fort Wayne, IN did not meet legal requirements.

Overall, the prices of the recommended bidders reflect a two percent decrease when compared to the last bid opened in July 1998.

Reads
Literacy
Grants

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Everybody Reads Literacy Grants:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of Everybody Reads Literacy Grants funded by the Lily Endowment Inc. in the amount of \$54,000.

RELATED INFORMATION: The Allen County Local Education Fund (funded by the Lily Endowment Inc.) requested competitive grant applications to support projects that:

- Help all Allen County children read at grade level by the completion of third grade.
- Encourage the development of literacy programs unique to the school environment.
- Unite community members in local efforts to improve reading skills of kindergarten to grade three students.

Grant applications are being submitted by the following elementary schools: Arlington, \$5,000; Brentwood, \$5,000; Forest Park, \$5,000; Holland, \$5,000; Indian Village, \$5,000; Northcrest, \$5,000; Pleasant Center, \$5,000; South Wayne, \$5,000; Washington, \$5,000; Waynedale, \$4,000; and Weisser Park, \$5,000.

Requested funds will be used for the implementation of programs that (1) teach parents how to support their children's literacy development, (2) stimulate students' reading and writing, (3) promote school-community partnerships, (4) encourage family literacy activities, (5) provide personal books for individual students, and (6) facilitate educators' professional development.

The grants address advancement intended and outlined in Strategy I, Personally Appropriate Education; and Strategy VI, Meaningful Relationships with Families. Coordination of the grants rests with individual principals and Sandy Sunderland-Willis.
