The specifications for this bid indicated that FWCS reserves the right to award bids such that no fewer than ten (10) items are supplied by any one vendor.

Bids were mailed to ten prospective bidders with six responding.

Overall, the prices of the recommended bidders reflect one percent increase when compared to the last bid opened in October 2003.
