He thinks "Redskins" is a derogatory racial name used to insult people and he is happy to see it changed.</p> <p>Former Board Member Lisa Olinger asked the administration and Board members to look at brain issues and the science of literacy and how children learn. She recently had a stroke and has learned much on this topic. Ms. Olinger also commented about the North Side mascot issue and encouraged everyone to have a conversation and listen to both sides of the issue.</p> <p>Ms. Helen Frost Thompson spoke to the Board in favor of changing the name of the mascot for North Side High School. Good intentions are not an excuse to continue a hurtful practice.</p> <p>Mr. Clifford Lane spoke to Board members about an issue with his child and President GiaQuinta referred him to a central office administrator.</p>
