Dr. Wendy Robinson, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

SkillsUSA National Leadership Recognition **RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board recognize Anthis Career Center students who participated at the SkillsUSA National Leadership Conference.

RELATED INFORMATION: At the SkillsUSA National Leadership Conference, students compete in hands-on events challenging their expertise in occupations such as robotics, computer programming, precision machining, medical assisting and culinary arts. Contests are run with the help of industry, trade associations and labor organizations. Seven Anthis students were among the over 5,000 individuals in 91 contests at the June 23-27 event in Kansas City, Missouri. The students attending the conference were among the top 2% skilled in the nation and had to work their way through a series of local, regional and state competitions.

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the School Technology Advancement Account Application:

School Technology Advancement Account Application

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and the receipt of an advancement from the School Technology Advancement Account in the amount of \$631,000 for the 2008-2009 school year.

RELATED INFORMATION: The School Technology Advancement Account provides funds annually for school systems to purchase computer technology for student instruction. The Fort Wayne Community Schools uses these moneys to fund learning and technology plans of schools.

The request of \$631,000 is based on a guideline provided by the state of \$500 for each 25 students. Funds are provided in the form of a loan with a very low interest rate. The last loan under this program had an interest rate of 1 percent. Funds would be budgeted in the Debt Service Fund to repay this loan beginning in 2010.

Change in Board Policy #175.1

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Change in Board Policy #175.1:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended by the Board that bylaw 175.1, School Board Conferences, Conventions, and Workshops be changed as noted below in **bold**.

RELATED INFORMATION: 0175.1 School Board Conferences, Conventions, and Workshops

Attendance at meetings directly or indirectly related to education or school matters shall be encouraged for the value they have to the school corporation and the professional growth of Board members.

In order to maintain fiscal responsibility and equity between members while encouraging attendance at such meetings, reimbursement of reasonable and necessary travel and meeting expenses will be made from corporation funds for all in-state meetings and for one out-of-state meeting per calendar year without additional approval. Requests for reimbursement for additional meetings shall be directed to the Board President, who shall have the authority to approve or disapprove attendance based upon perceived value to the corporation.

Meeting attendees will be expected to attend, participate and report to the Board on the subject matter of the meeting.

Discussion

Board members generally agreed that there is value to attending conferences. However, there is a need to coordinate trips; have everyone agree who will attend which conferences; establish priorities for conferences attended; and establish a format for reporting back to the entire Board on each session attended during a conference. President GiaQuinta will work with FWCS Attorney Bill Sweet to draft another revision to the Board Policy.

High Ability (Gifted and Talented) Grant Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the High Ability (Gifted and Talented) Grant:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of a High Ability (Gifted and Talented) Grant for 2008-2009 from the Indiana Department of Education in the amount of \$168,161.

RELATED INFORMATION: The state of Indiana provides non-competitive funds for districts to address the learning needs of high ability students. Funds for 2008-2009 will be used:

- To provide an appropriate education for identified high ability students through differentiated Levels of Service and program options; and
- To provide a special assignment High Ability Program Specialist to train teachers on the characteristics and educational needs of high ability students and on strategies for educating such students within the classroom.

Currently, high ability (gifted and talented) services are delivered through the efforts of classroom teachers and supported by Thinking Skills Coaches in every building. The overall program is coordinated by Nancy Stansberry in Curriculum Services.

The grant addresses Goal 1: Achieve and Maintain Academic Excellence.
