2014-15 Grant Application Title III: Language Instruction for Limited English Proficient and Immigrant

Students

Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the 2014-15 Grant Application Title III: Language Instruction for Limited English Proficient and Immigrant Students:

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of the Title III: Language Instruction for Limited English Proficient and Immigrant Students for 2014-15 in the amount of \$457,379.00 from the Office of English Learning and Migrant Programs of the Indiana Department of Education.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: The Title III grant is federal funding allocated annually by the Indiana Department of Education based on the number of limited English proficient (LEP) students in Fort Wayne Community Schools during the previous school year. Funds from this grant will allow for the continuation of a range of supplemental services for the district's English Language Learners (ELL) program. The funds in this year's grant are specifically designated for supplemental instructional materials and professional development.

This non-competitive grant written by Emily Schwartz Keirns, ELL coordinator, supports advancement intended and outlined in the FWCS District Goals I: *Achieve and Maintain Academic Excellence* and Goal II: *Engage Parents and the Community*.

Questions will be answered by the Manager of the ELL Department, Emily Schwartz-Keirns.

A motion was made by Julie Hollingsworth, seconded by Becky Hill, that the recommendation concerning the 2014-15 Grant Application Title III: Language Instruction for Limited English Proficient and Immigrant Students be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Park Center Case Managers for Elementary Emotional Disabilities Programs Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Park Center Case Managers for Elementary Emotional Disabilities Programs:

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve the contract to provide case managers in our elementary programs for students with emotional disabilities for the amount of \$165,000.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: During the 2011/12 and 2012/13 school year we initiated pilot programs at St. Joe Center and Price Elementary, and a half year program at South Wayne Elementary to reduce the need to place students in programs outside their school setting. By the end of the 2012/13 school year we had reduced the need to access outside alternative placement by 73%. During the 2013/14 school year we further reduced outside alternative placements by 89%. Each of the eleven elementary programs will have a case manager during the school day to support FWCS staff with student's behavioral needs. The case managers will have the following duties:

- Provide social skills group
- Keep accurate records of the daily services provided
- Observe students and assist teacher with the collection of data
- Assist with de-escalating behaviors and processes with students to return to the educational setting which allows the teacher to continue to provide instruction
- Assist in transitioning students from services in the special education setting to services in the general education setting.

The grant supports District Goal I: *Achieving and Maintaining Academic Excellence* and is managed by Ann Barnes-Smith who will answer any questions.

A motion was made by Julie Hollingsworth, seconded by Becky Hill, that the recommendation concerning the Park Center Case Managers for Elementary Emotional Disabilities Programs be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Ratification of Hearing and Visually Impaired Interpreters Wage Increase Upon a motion from Stephen Corona, seconded by Jordan Lebamoff and with no objections the Board recommendations for Ratification of Hearing and Visually Impaired Interpreters Wage Increase and Non Union Salary Increase were considered and voted upon together.

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board ratify an agreement between Fort Wayne Community Schools and AFSCME that Hearing and Visually Impaired Interpreters receive a one dollar (\$1.00) per hour increase to their base wage effective the beginning of the 2014-2015 school year.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: On Monday, February 25, 2014, the Board ratified a two (2) year agreement between FWCS and AFSCME. The agreement included a wage increase of \$1.00 along with a 2% raise for school year employees represented by AFSCME. The Hearing and Visually Impaired Interpreters represented by AFSCME are school year employees and did not receive a one dollar (\$1.00) base wage increase in 2013-2014.

## Non Union Salary Increase

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve a two percent (2%) salary increase for the 2014-15 contract year for Salary Schedules I, II and III, Meet & Confer groups, other non-union groups and classified substitutes paid on a fiscal year schedule.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: This pay increase is the same as agreed upon with the Classified, Nurses, and AFSCME unions.

### Schwab Foundation Donation

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve the acceptance of a donation from the Schwab Foundation for College and Career Readiness.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: The Schwab Foundation has awarded Fort Wayne Community Schools \$157,890 for the purpose of promoting College and Career Readiness in our secondary schools. Funds will be used for technology updates and training related to the replacement of *Navigation 101* with the online college and career program *Kuder*; ACT waivers as well as *Job Keys*, a program to help students prepare to take the ACT and costs related to college visits for underserved high school juniors and seniors.

Use of funds for these programs/plans will be guided by the Schwab Foundation mission: "... to identify and support programs that help middle and high school students connect their education to their future career choices by providing the resources and opportunities they need to investigate, explore, and experience the array of career options available to them in a 21st century global economy."
