#### **OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS**

Roll Call

The Board of School Trustees of the Fort Wayne Community Schools met in regular session in the Lester L. Grile Administrative Center on Monday, August 23, 2004, at 7:03 p.m. President Carol J. Coen called the meeting to order with the following members in attendance:

Approval of Minutes – August 9, 2004 A motion was made by Robert A. Armstrong, seconded by Carl A. Johnson, that the minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees held August 9, 2004, be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Wendy Robinson, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

ISTA-Horace Mann Hoosier Educator Award – Albert Jacquay, Northrop High

School

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board recognize Albert Jacquay, an art teacher at Northrop High School, for receiving the Horace Mann Hoosier Educator Award from the Indiana State Teachers Association.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: This prestigious award recognizes excellence in teaching and advocacy for the education profession. The recognition comes with a plaque and a cash award of \$2,500.

Albert Jacquay has been an educator with FWCS for 28 years. During that time, he has established a reputation for his teaching and community involvement. He has received several local, state and national awards for his achievements in education.

He was nominated for the ISTA award by Steve Brace, president of the Fort Wayne Education Association. The following individuals were recognized:

Vouchers

Dr. Robinson presented the vouchers for the period ending August 11, 2004, with the recommendation the vouchers be approved. A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Robert A. Armstrong, that the vouchers appearing in the listing numbered 04-15 be approved without exception. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Robinson presented the following information concerning the Public Hearing on the 2005 Budgets and Capital Projects Plan:

Public Hearing 2005 Budgets and Capital Projects Plan A public budget presentation was made at the August 9, 2004, regular Board of School Trustees meeting. All nine tax-rated funds and proposed budgets were discussed, and estimated tax rates were reviewed. The budgets were advertised on August 10 and August 17, 2004. The hearing on the nine tax-rated fund budgets and the Capital Projects Plan is scheduled for this evening's meeting of the Board of School Trustees.

The intent of the hearing is to allow Board members the opportunity to receive community input. Board members will be asked to vote on the 2005 budgets and the Capital Projects Plan on September 13, 2004. Kathy Friend, chief financial officer, was available to answer questions.

This was the appropriate time for members of the public to address the Board regarding the year 2005 budgets and the Capital Projects Plan. The hearing was held and there were no comments from the public.

Public Hearing 2005-2014 School Bus Replacement Plan Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Public Hearing on the 2005-2014 School Bus Replacement Plan:

According to Indiana Code 21-2-11.5-3.1, effective July 1, 1995, the school corporation must conduct a public hearing on a ten-year bus replacement plan before the governing body may collect property taxes for the school transportation fund's school bus replacement account. The Bus Replacement Plan was advertised on August 10 and August 17, 2004. The hearing on the Bus Replacement Plan is scheduled for this evening's meeting of the Board of School Trustees. Board members will be asked to vote on the plan on September 13, 2004.

The Bus Replacement Plan calls for the purchase of 33 replacement buses for the 334 bus fleet. Due to the tax neutrality requirement of the pension bond law, we recommend that the purchase be reduced. This bus replacement reduction will not negatively impact the fleet.

The intent of the hearing is to allow Board members the opportunity to receive community input and to consider the Bus Replacement Plan. This was the appropriate time for members of the public to address the Board regarding the Bus Replacement Plan. The hearing was held and there were no comments from the public.

School Technology Advancement Account Application Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the School Technology Advancement Account Application:

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and the receipt of an advancement from the School Technology Advancement Account in the amount of \$637,000 for the 2004-2005 school year.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: The School Technology Advancement Account provides funds annually for school systems to purchase computer technology for student instruction. The Fort Wayne Community Schools uses these moneys to fund learning and technology plans of schools.

The request of \$637,000 is based on a guideline provided by the state of \$500 for each 25 students. Funds are provided in the form of a loan with a very low interest rate. The last loan under this program had an interest rate of 1 percent. Funds would be budgeted in the Debt Service Fund to repay this loan beginning in 2006.

A motion was made by Kurt A. Walborn, seconded by Jon J. Olinger, that the recommendation concerning the School Technology Advancement Account Application be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Renewal of Insurance Policies Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Renewal of Insurance Policies:

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that insurance coverage for property, commercial general liability, inland marine, foreign package, business automobile, commercial umbrella liability, law enforcement professional liability, school leaders' errors and omissions, and boiler and machinery be awarded through our agent Acordia Insurance to five underwriting carriers at a cost of \$1,574,726.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: After several years of skyrocketing insurance premiums, FWCS and other commercial insurance buyers are seeing a break in the trend. Premiums increased 3.7 percent with this renewal effective September 1, 2004. Some improvements were obtained in the property insurance coverage, but other coverage will remain essentially the same. The commercial package and business automobile coverage will remain with the Indiana Insurance Company. Indiana Insurance insures 86 percent of the school corporations in Indiana and provides the best alternative among a limited number of carriers. They not only offer programs which afford the necessary coverage to address the exposures of a public school corporation, but provide the claims administration and risk management services to support their customers

A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Carl A. Johnson, that the recommendation concerning the Renewal of Insurance Policies be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

2004-2005 Special Education Grants Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the 2004-2005 Special Education Grants:

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of special education grants from the Indiana Department of Education for the school year 2004-2005.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: This noncompetitive grant is to offset the cost of special education services. The reauthorization of PL 105-7, IDEA requires that after the base payment allocations are made, additional funding is awarded to each district based on public and private school enrollment within the FWCS jurisdiction and number of children living in poverty (National School Lunch Act participants).

The local educational agency will receive a base payment amount of \$518.28 for each child (ages 5-22). The base payment for preschool is \$484.59.

The PL 105-17 Part B, IDEA grant amount for the 2004-2005 school year is \$7,595,155. This is an increase of \$1,004,620 over the 2003-2004 school year.

The PL 105-17 Section 619 preschool grant for 2004-2005 is \$293,861. This is a decrease of \$5,788 from the 2003-2004 school year.

The funds will be used to support salaries and fringes of approximately one hundred ten (110) teachers, three (3) administrators, twenty-five (25) instructional assistants, clerical staff, and other related services.

Under the provisions of IDEA–1997, a grant program was established to promote innovation and program development. The amount of this PL 105-17 Sub grant is \$101,730 which will be used to provide support for students with autism and behavior issues.

During the 2004-2005 school year, an additional PL-105-17 award will be granted to Fort Wayne Community Schools in the amount of \$530,000. These funds will be used to support salaries and fringes for ten (10) teachers to implement the K-2 Project in fifteen (15) schools.

These funds are used in support of FWCS Strategy 1 - We will insure high levels of learning for all students.
