Approval of Minutes – August 11, 2008 A motion was made by Mitch Sheppard, seconded by Jon J. Olinger, that the minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees held August 11, 2008, be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Dr. Wendy Robinson, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

Blessings in a Backpack Fundraiser **RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board recognize community members who organized and supported the major fundraiser for Blessings in a Backpack on August 5, 2008.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: Blessings in a Backpack is a program established by USA Harvest that provides six meals to children on weekends. The food is packed in backpacks that are sent home with the children on Fridays and returned empty each Monday, to be repacked again the end of the week. This program was started by Mike and Gretchen Gouloff and SchenkelShultz at Adams Elementary in spring of 2007 as a pilot and implemented for the full year in 2007-2008. It is very important because the single most influential factor impeding student achievement is poverty. The program was started at Adams because it had the highest percentage of children with families qualifying for free and reduced-price lunches at the time. Since then, the Gouloffs have been working to raise funds to expand the program to other schools. This year they teamed with local attorney Paul Sauerteig to put on a wonderful event that raised enough funds to add another school – South Wayne Elementary — to the program. Paul Sauerteig was responsible for bringing world-renowned chef Charlie Trotter to Fort Wayne to prepare dinner for a sold-out group. Mr. Sauerteig and the Gouloffs organized the entire event, which not only raised funds for Blessings in a Backpack, but also raised awareness of the needs of children in our community.

The Board and FWCS Administration wish to publicly recognize and thank Mike and Gretchen Gouloff and Paul Sauerteig for their caring and commitment to ensuring that hunger is not a barrier to student achievement.

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board recognize the Elmhurst JAG program for winning a national award and WorkOne of Northeast Indiana for its partnership with FWCS.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: Elmhurst High School's JAG (Jobs for America's Graduates) program has been recognized for being one of the top-performing JAG programs in the country. JAG is a school-to-career program aimed at keeping young people in school through graduation and providing work-based learning experiences that will lead to a rewarding career. It is offered at four FWCS high schools through a partnership with WorkOne of Northeast Indiana. The Elmhurst program, led by Kristine Etter, received a 5 of 5 Award, which is given to JAG programs that are making sure its students are finding success after leaving the program. Elmhurst exceeded the required success rates in every category. Kathleen Randolph, President and CEO of WorkOne of Northeast Indiana, was recognized as a High Performer for outstanding program development and stake holder. JAG-Indiana was recognized as a Top State Organization.

Curriculum Services and Professional Development Recognition

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that the Board recognize the FWCS Curriculum Services and Professional Development departments for the instructional support and training that that took place in the weeks before school started.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: The FWCS Curriculum Services and Professional Development departments made full use of the summer break time to assist teachers and administrators in their preparations for the 2008-09 school year. Curriculum Services personnel ensured that new adoption materials were in classrooms for the opening of school and that educators had a full understanding of how to use them. They also updated many instructional tools such as curriculum maps, assessments, career interest surveys, and sample lesson plans.

Sessions to help teachers be more precise in teaching was the focal point of the district's Conference on Effective Instruction, which included forty professional development opportunities during August 11 – 13. The training culminated in the first required professional development day held for all teachers at the Coliseum on August 14. Dr. Deb Estes, an expert in brain research and education, demonstrated master teaching as she helped teachers and administrators learn to build effective instruction through an understanding of how the brain learns. The day was inspirational and provided a great start for the school year.

First Day of School Video On Monday, August 18, more than 32,000 students returned to school for a year full of new experiences. The staff and students at each school were welcomed back by administrators and/or Board members. A video was shown to highlight some of the activities on the first day.

Vouchers

Dr. Robinson presented the vouchers for the period ending August 25, 2008, with the recommendation the vouchers be approved. A motion was made by Pamela Martin-Díaz, seconded by John Peirce, that the vouchers appearing in the listing dated August 25, 2008, be approved without exception. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Renewal of Insurance Policies Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Renewal of Insurance Policies:

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that insurance coverage for property, commercial general liability, inland marine, foreign package, business automobile, commercial umbrella liability, law enforcement professional liability, school leaders errors and omissions, and boiler and machinery be awarded through Wells Fargo Insurance Services of Indiana to three underwriting carriers at a cost of \$1,058,004.

**RELATED INFORMATION**: Total premiums increased \$1,566 or about one tenth of one percent with this renewal effective September 1. The Indiana Insurance Company will remain the largest underwriter for our coverage. Indiana Insurance insures a large majority of the school corporations in Indiana and provides the best alternative among a limited number of carriers. They not only offer programs which afford the necessary coverage to address the exposures of a public school corporation, but provide the claims administration and risk management services to support their customers.

A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Kevin Brown, that the recommendation concerning the Renewal of Insurance Policies be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Public Hearing on the 2009 Budgets and Capital Projects Plan A public budget presentation was made at the August 11, 2008, regular Board of School Trustees meeting. All nine Board adopted funds and proposed budgets were discussed, and estimated tax rates were reviewed. The budgets were advertised on August 14 and August 21, 2008. The hearing on the nine Board adopted fund budgets and the Capital Projects Plan is scheduled for this evening's meeting of the Board of School Trustees.

The intent of the hearing is to allow Board members the opportunity to receive community input. Board members will be asked to vote on the 2009 budgets and the Capital Projects Plan on September 8, 2008. Chief Financial Officer Kathy Friend is available to answer questions.

Public Hearing on the 2009-2020 School Bus Replacement Plan According to Indiana Code 20-46.5-11, effective July 1, 1995, the school corporation must conduct a public hearing on a twelve-year bus replacement plan before the governing body may collect property taxes for the school transportation fund's school bus replacement account. The Bus Replacement Plan was advertised on August 14 and August 21, 2008. The hearing on the Bus Replacement Plan is scheduled for this evening's meeting of the Board of School Trustees. Board members will be asked to vote on the plan on September 8, 2008.

The Bus Replacement Plan calls for the purchase of 15 replacement buses for the 340 bus fleet along with 2 additional 84 passenger buses for full-day kindergarten and an additional eleven 15 passenger special purposes buses. Due to the tax neutrality requirement of the pension bond law, we recommend that the purchase be reduced to 17 at the tax hearing. This bus replacement reduction will not negatively impact the fleet.

The intent of this hearing is to allow Board members the opportunity to receive community input and to consider the Bus Replacement Plan.
