Visitors

Mr. GiaQuinta invited students forward who are visiting from Taizhou, China to sing their national anthem. Nineteen students from North Side's Sister City School Xinhe High School are visiting Fort Wayne to tour the sites and visit with North Side students and families. The visiting students presented the Board, Dr. Robinson and High School Area Administrator D. Faye Williams-Robbins with gifts from China. Dorothy Kittaka and Dick Conklin, representing from Fort Wayne Sister Cities International, thanked the Board and North Side High School for hosting the group.

Dr. Wendy Robinson, superintendent, presented the following information and recommendations concerning awards and recognitions:

First Day of School Video On Monday, August 19, Fort Wayne Community School students returned to school for a year full of new experiences. The staff and students at each school were welcomed back by administrators and Board members. A video highlighting some of the activities on the first day and preparations for the 2013 school year was shown.

Christopher Columbus Award

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board recognize the Memorial Park Middle School "The Bright Idea" team for being named finalists in the Christopher Columbus Awards competition.

RELATED INFORMATION: A team of four Memorial Park 8th grade students competed with 225 middle school teams in the national Christopher Columbus Awards competition. In the first round of judging, the team was one of 30 semi-finalists chosen. A second round of judges narrowed the finalists to eight teams. The first two rounds of judging were based on the written entry. At the finals, Memorial Park's "The Bright Idea" team competed before seven judges at the Coronado Springs resort at Walt Disney World in Orlando, Florida. The students presented their research on the best bottle light to install in homes in developing countries where electricity is not available or affordable. Although they did not win the competition, being one of the eight national finalists was a high honor. They enjoyed the all-expenses paid five day trip to Disney World and the chance to promote their idea to a wider audience. With the promotional aid of Associated Churches of Fort Wayne & Allen County, the team is continuing the application of its project by supplying materials and instructions to groups that are traveling to developing countries.

The Memorial Park teams have been semifinalists or better for ten of the last eleven years. Mr. Lesh enjoys working with the students and the school is grateful for the time he is willing to volunteer.

Clean School Awards – Gold Standard **RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board recognize Sodexo and the FWCS schools with the highest-ranking scores on inspections of building maintenance and cleanliness for the 2012-13 school year.

RELATED INFORMATION: Ensuring high standards of cleanliness and maintenance of FWCS buildings and grounds is a top priority for the Maintenance and Operations Department and custodial provider Sodexo. Supervisors complete two random inspections during the year to keep custodial staff and principals informed about the condition of their buildings. Consent Agenda A motion was made by Stephen Corona, seconded by Jordan Lebamoff that the following consent agenda items be approved: Minutes from the Regular Meeting held August 12, 2013; Vouchers for the Period Ending August 26, 2013 and Personnel Report. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Application for Common School Fund Loan Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the Application for Common School Fund Loan:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of an advancement from the Indiana Common School Fund for educational technology equipment in the amount of \$1,950,000.

RELATED INFORMATION: Advancements from the Common School Fund provide funds for school districts to purchase educational technology. The Fort Wayne Community Schools (FWCS) will use these moneys to help fund the FWCS technology plan previously submitted to the state. Technology funds are currently insufficient to fund all the technology needs of the school corporation.

Funds are provided as a loan and are awarded to school corporations on the basis of assessed value (AV) per pupil, with low AV per pupil school corporations receiving funds before high AV per pupil corporations. FWCS therefore cannot be assured of receiving the requested advancement.

Should the application be successful, funds will be budgeted in the Debt Service Fund to repay this loan beginning in the year 2015. Interest on the loan is expected to be no more than four percent and is likely to be as low as one percent.

Common School Fund advancements differ from School Technology Advancement Account (STAA) loans, which FWCS receives on an annual basis. Unlike CSF advancements, STAA advancements are given to all applying school corporations, regardless of their assessed value per pupil ranking.

A motion was made by Jordan Lebamoff, seconded by Becky Hill, that the recommendation concerning the Application for Common School Fund Loan be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

North Side High School - Student Trip to China June 2014 Dr. Robinson presented the following recommendation concerning the North Side High School – Student Trip to China June 2014:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve a trip to China for North Side High School students June 18-28, 2014. Students will visit North Side's Sister City School and meet the students they have been communicating with via email.

RELATED INFORMATION: In June 2014, North Side students will participate in a 10-day tour of China. Student's will explore the cities and historical sites of Shanghai, Taizhou, Hanzhouz and Beijing and visit with students at North Side's Sister City School. The tour is sponsored by Education First (EF) tours. Students will have opportunities to fund raise to cover the cost of the trip. North Side teachers Erin Baumgartner and Melanie DeGrandchamp will accompany the group as well as North Side Principal, Chad Hissong, North Side Staff member, Bev Metzger, Northwood staff member, Anh

Nguyen and Natalie Nelson from FWCS Academic Services. A full-time EF bi-lingual tour director will accompany the group at all times when abroad.
