### **OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS**

The Board of School Trustees of the Fort Wayne Community Schools met in regular session in the Lester L. Grile Administrative Center on Monday, August 26, 2002, at 7:05 p.m. President Stephen Corona called the meeting to order with the following members in attendance:

Approval of Minutes – August 12, 2002

Roll Call

A motion was made by Carol J. Coen, seconded by Carl A. Johnson, that the minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees held August 12, 2002, be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, Stephen Corona, Carol J. Coen, Jero me F. Henry, Sr., Carl A. Johnson, Bettye J. Poignard; abstained due to absent, Jon J. Olinger; nays, none.

FWCS Teacher of the Year **RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board recognize Lawanda Windom as this year's Fort Wayne Community Schools Teacher of the Year.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** Each year, FWCS honors an outstanding classroom teacher as Teacher of the Year. Lawanda Windom, a sixth-grade social studies teacher at Lane Middle School, has been selected for this honor. The recognition takes place as part of the Indiana State Teacher of the Year program. A video was shown.

Vouchers

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the vouchers for the period ending August 14, 2002, with the recommendation the vouchers be approved. A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Bettye J. Poignard, that the vouchers appearing in the listing numbered 02-16 be approved without exception. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Budget Adoption Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Budget Adoption:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the proposed FWCS 2003 appropriations (budgets), the 2003 levies, the three-year Capital Projects Fund plan for 2003 through 2005, and the Bus Replacement Plan for the years 2003 to 2012.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** A public presentation of the proposed budgets and tax rates was made at the July 22, 2002 regular Board meeting. The budgets were advertised on July 24 and again on July 31. A hearing to allow the public to make comments on the advertised budgets, the three-year Capital Projects Plan, and the ten-year Bus Replacement Plan was held on August 26, 2002.

All legal requirements for advertisement and hearings have been met for all seven tax-rated funds, the Capital Projects Plan, and the Bus Replacement Plan.

A motion was made by Carol J. Coen, seconded by Bettye J. Poignard, that the recommendation concerning the Budget Adoption be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Student Rights and Responsibilities and Behavior Code Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning Student Rights and Responsibilities and Behavior Code:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the 2002-2003 Student Rights and Responsibilities and Behavior Code booklet.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** This document, first created in 1996, was developed to assist schools in providing consistency and fairness in disciplinary matters. This year, minor changes were recommended by the Indiana School Board Association. These changes have also been reviewed and approved by legal council. This booklet reflects those changes. They include a revision of rules 27 and 30. Both changes have become necessary due to recent tragedies which have occurred in other school districts across the country. These two changes add language that permit expulsion proceedings to occur if a student has knowledge of another person's intent to commit a homicide, or arson, and fails to report it to school officials.

A third change clarifies that an expulsion occurs if a student is found to be attending FWCS and his legal settlement is not in the boundaries of the district.

A motion was made by Bettye J. Poignard, seconded by Carol J. Coen, that the recommendation concerning the Student Rights and Responsibilities and Behavior Code be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Renewal of Insurance Policies Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Renewal of Insurance Policies:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that insurance coverage for property, commercial general liability, inland marine, foreign package, flood and surface water, business automobile, commercial umbrella liability, law enforcement professional liability, school leaders errors and omissions, and boiler and machinery be awarded through our agent Acordia Insurance to five underwriting carriers at a cost of \$1,812,350.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** Our agent Mr. Niezer informed us that the commercial insurance marketplace enjoyed a "soft" or competitive cycle for the ten years beginning 1990 providing very liberal coverage and very competitive pricing. The profitability of the insurance industry has changed in the last three years creating a more restrictive marketplace and, as a result, a significant increase in the cost of insurance. The average premium increase for school corporations with Indiana Insurance is about 30 percent. The overall 45 percent increase for FWCS is above the average mainly due to our recent flood claim. Indiana Insurance insures 86 percent of the school corporations in Indiana, and Indiana provided the best alternative for our commercial package, business auto, and commercial umbrella liability insurance. They not only offer programs which afford the necessary coverage to address the exp osures of a public school corporation, but provide the claims administration and risk management services to support their customers.

This package provides fewer benefits to FWCS. Deductibles are increasing from \$25,000 to \$50,000, flood/surface water coverage is only provided for those schools in the flood zone and the ten other schools that were recently flooded, new coverage exclusions include terrorism and fungi or bacteria. FWCS may obtain additional flood/surface water coverage through the Federal Flood Insurance program at an additional cost.

A motion was made by Bettye J. Poignard, seconded by Carol J. Coen, that the recommendation concerning the Renewal of Insurance Policies be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Parkview Hospital Grant for Anthis Career Center Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Parkview Hospital Grant for Anthis Career Center:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of \$23,000.00 in grant funds from Parkview Hospital's Community Benefit Program.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** Parkview's Community Benefit Program is designed to support and assist organizations in enhancing the healthcare of our community and providing for the citizens of the area. If awarded, grant funds will be used to establish the Medical Assist course at Anthis Career Center beginning in 2002-2003, with purchase of medical equipment, Dictaphone equipment, instructional materials and computer software. This course is a second year program that will offer Unit Clerk Certification which is an entry level certification that allows a hospital employee to work with patient charts and input physician orders.

The Anthis Career Center is adding additional opportunities in the medical career field for students in FWCS and Area 14. Labor market data for Allen and Whitley County indicates health care workers are in great demand.

This is a competitive grant written by Rhonda Templar, Allied Health Department Head at Anthis. The program supports advancement intended and outlined in Strategy I, Personally Appropriate Education and Strategy X, Develop and Maintain Significant Linkages with Community Resources.

A motion was made by Bettye J. Poignard, seconded by Carol J. Coen, that the recommendation concerning the Parkview Hospital Grant for Anthis Career Center be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

2002-2003 Perkins Grant Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the 2002-2003 Perkins Grant:

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board authorize the application for and acceptance of the Carl D. Perkins grant for \$805,488.00 for the 2002-03 school year.

**RELATED INFORMATION:** The Area 14 Vocational Education Office, located at the Anthis Career Center administers the Perkins funds for the benefit of over 3,000 vocational education students in Allen County, Columbia City, and Churubusco. This year the Perkins Funds, distributed to the vocational areas via a formula determined by the Indiana Department of Workforce Development, have increased from \$748,171.00 in 2001-2002 to \$805,488.00 in 2002-2003.

The Fort Wayne Community Schools is the fiscal agent for these funds. There is no requirement to match the grant with local funds.

The funding will include support of the following areas:

Adult Continuing Education (apprenticeship classes and Youth Life Skills)

Counseling and guidance services for area vocational students

Developing basic occupational and academic skills for special needs students

Expansion and Improvement of existing career and technical education programs

Providing transitional services and occupational skills development for handicapped students

Recruitment/Program Promotion/Community/and Educational leadership

Staff Development, in-service, curriculum development, and assessment in career and technical education

This non-competitive grant written by Ron Flickenger, Area Vocational Coordinator, supports Strategy I, Personally Appropriate Education, of the Fort Wayne Community Schools Strategic Plan.
