OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS

The Board of School Trustees of the Fort Wayne Community Schools met in regular session in the Lester L. Grile Administrative Center on Monday, September 9, 2002, at 7:06 p.m. President Stephen Corona called the meeting to order with the following members in attendance:

Approval of Minutes -August 26, 2002

A motion was made by Jon J. Olinger, seconded by Bettye J. Poignard, that the minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of School Trustees held August 26, 2002, be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, Stephen Corona, Carol J. Coen, Jerome F. Henry, Sr., Carl A. Johnson, Jon J. Olinger, Bettye J. Poignard; abstained due to absence, Donald J. Schaab; nays, none.

Staff Spotlight -Earl Hoke, Bus Driver, South Transportation

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board recognize Earl Hoke, bus driver, for his contributions to the children and families of Fort Wayne Community Schools.

RELATED INFORMATION: The Staff Spotlight program is the district's method of recognizing employees for outstanding work and commitment to excellence. Tonight we honor Earl Hoke, who has driven a bus for Fort Wayne Community Schools for the past 39 years. Not only has he inspired students and faculty with his perpetually positive demeanor, but he is an exceptional driver who has never had an accident. He is so beloved by all at Pleasant Center Elementary School, he was asked to serve on their school improvement planning committee. A task he gladly accepted.

A video highlighting his accomplishments was shown.

This program addresses advancement intended and outlined in Strategy V, Ensuring Staff Effectiveness; and Strategy VIII, Communicating that FWCS is an Excellent School System.

Vouchers

RELATED INFORMATION: The current school site is significantly below the state minimum acreage recommendation. The purchase prices are the average of two appraisals. Funds are within budget.

Extension of School Bus Bid

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation to Extend School Bus Bid:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that an award be made to extend the school bus bid opened in October 2001.

Midwest Transit Equipment of Indiana, Inc., Indianapolis, IN \$2,408,869.00 For 29 ea 84-Passenger Buses 4 ea 48-Passenger Buses

The bid includes a quantity discount of \$2,000 per unit with the purchase of 27 or more units.

RELATED INFORMATION: New emission standards are forthcoming from the EPA to begin October 1, 2002. New bus engines would increase approximately \$1,800.00. This increase would be in addition to a general price increase of three percent. The bid extension will provide cost savings by retaining the current unit costs and the existing engines.

FWCS has experienced fewer problems and recalls with the current model which ultimately represents lower maintenance costs.

The bid is part of the scheduled replacement of the bus fleet. Funding for these purchases will be from the Transportation Fund.

A motion was made by Carl A. Johnson, seconded by Donald J. Schaab, that the recommendation to Extend School Bus Bid be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Extension of Activity Bus Quote

Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the recommendation to Extend Activity Bus Quote:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that an award be made to extend the activity bus quote opened in February 2001.

Midwest Transit Equipment of Indiana, Inc., Indianapolis, IN \$361,592.00 For 11 ea 15-Passenger Activity Buses

RELATED INFORMATION: The bid extension will provide cost savings by retaining the current unit costs. In addition, FWCS has experienced fewer problems and recalls with the current activity buses which ultimately represent lower maintenance costs.

Funding for these purchases will be from the Transportation Fund. According to the approved bus replacement plan, four of the buses will be purchased in 2002 and seven of the buses will be purchased in 2003.

A motion was made by Carol J. Coen, seconded by Donald J. Schaab, that the recommendation to Extend Activity Bus Quote be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.

Sale of Used Buses, PB #8100 Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation for Sale of Used Buses, PB #8100:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the sale of 33 used buses, 1993 and 1994 models, be awarded to the highest responsive and responsible bidder.

Midwest Transit Equipment of Indiana, Inc., Indianapolis, IN \$413,000.00

RELATED INFORMATION: Invitations to Bid were mailed to four prospective bidders with three responding. Speedway International, Indianapolis, IN submitted a "No Bid" and William G. Myers, Angola, IN did not respond.

Phone System Upgrade, RFP #7998 Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the Phone System Upgrade, RFP #7998:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that an award be made to the lowest total proposal meeting specifications and quality standards to:

Verizon North, Fort Wayne, IN \$425,545.95

RELATED INFORMATION: The phone system upgrade will replace the current Nortel phone system with a new Private Brand Exchange (PBX) telecommunications system. This purchase will be funded entirely by the second year Universal Service Fund (USF) reimbursements.

The current phone system was implemented during 1994. While this system has provided excellent service to FWCS, the system has reached its capacity in many buildings and cannot provide the required functionality needed in a cost efficient manner.

This project includes installation of the central processing unit that will provide service to the Grile and Anthis complexes, connects the South Transportation Center to the central PBX, connects Northrop High School to the central PBX, and interfaces the remaining Nortel systems into the PBX system. As new USF projects, renovations, and other technology projects occur, the impacted schools will be connected directly to the PBX system.

A Request for Proposal was sent to eight vendors with three responding. Of these three, Avaya, Incorporated, Indianapolis, IN did not meet the proposal specifications.

After review by the School Board president, superintendent, and legal counsel, it is recommended that the Board refuse to consider the appeal for the reasons that there is no unresolved issue of Board policy and/or there is no new evidence.

2002-03 Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Grant Dr. Fowler-Finn presented the following recommendation concerning the 2002-03 Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Grant:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board approve the application for and acceptance of the Title IV - Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities grant in the amount of \$244,479.00 for the 2002-2003 school year.

RELATED INFORMATION: The Indiana Department of Education has notified us that Fort Wayne Community Schools district qualifies for \$244,479.00 which is an increase of \$99,197.00. Fort Wayne Community Schools' portion of the grant is \$183,003.23, an increase of \$71,013.23 plus indirect and administrative costs.

Participating nonpublic schools have been allocated \$49,815.07 which is an increase of \$16,523.07.

Fort Wayne Community Schools' funding will be used to provide Pre-Adolescent Responsibility Thinking training in the elementary alternative programs; Adolescent Responsibility Thinking training at Kekionga and Northwood middle schools; classes for parents in Adolescent Responsibility Thinking; and Bully Busters at Kekionga Middle School. The grant will pay for half of a nurse's salary and will include money for professional development.

Judy Platz, Manager of Pupil Personnel, is the coordinator of this non-competitive grant. Funds are used in support of the Strategic Plan Strategy III, Safe and Caring Environment, and Strategy X, Community Linkages.

A motion was made by Bettye J. Poignard, seconded by Carol J. Coen, that the 2002-03 Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Grant be approved. Roll Call: Ayes, unanimous; nays, none.
